Bobby McCullock, Carl Walters and Jane Connerat filed for Orange County elected offices Monday, the first day of filing.

McCullock, a security director, filed for Orange County sheriff. Walters, Orange County Planning Board vice chairman, filed for a seat on the Orange County Board of Commissioners, and Connerat, a Carrboro attorney, filed for clerk of Orange County Superior Court.

County offices up for election are: sheriff, register of deeds, clerk of superior court, three seats on the board of commissioners, district attorney, district court judge and four seats on the Orange County Board of Education.

Two state representatives and two state senators will also be elected in Orange County.

Feb. 3 is the final filing date for the May 6 party primary. Elections will be held on Nov. 4.
