Poole said the hardest part of his job as attorney general was charging a student with a violation.

"I feel badly for that person always," he said. "I've had upwards of 46 charges since I've been here, and none of them has been easy. A lot of them have been clear cut as far as whether to charge or not to charge, but none of them has ever been easy."

Poole also said it was difficult to remain detached from the people he charged, especially when he knew the pressure they had been under.

"The hardest part is thinking about the impact," he said. "It's easy to sit here and say, 'Wow, what am I doing to this person?' Maybe I can ignore it just this once, and I'm sure they won't do it again. Then you have to think about all those other students who come through here. And you have to make sure everyone gets the same treatment."

Johnston said the hardest part of chairing the Undergraduate Court was announcing the verdict.

"The toughest part is looking someone in the eye and telling them that you as a body have found them guilty," he said. "But because we go through such a thorough process of review in the hearing and the deliberation... I never really feel that uncomfortable with the decision. Even though it's hard, I never second-guess it."

If a guilty verdict is reached and the court decides the sanction is probation, the next stop for the student is to see Furr, who acts as a reference point for students who have questions about the honor system or just need someone to talk to about their problems.

"I can be tough when I have to be," Furr said. "You have to earn their respect. But I like to be viewed as a friend in the administration rather than an enforcer. I'd rather smile at someone than frown."

Unpremeditated violations

Furr said many of the students he sees were just under a lot of stress or did not know that what they had done was an Honor Code violation.

"They panic because they don't get prepared enough for an exam, and they get inside the exam and freeze up," she said. "They think their whole career depends upon it, and they cheat, something that normally would never be done. It's just the pressure."

"Sometimes you get people who didn't understand that it was plagiarism, or they didn't understand that just because everybody else was doing something they were going to get caught."

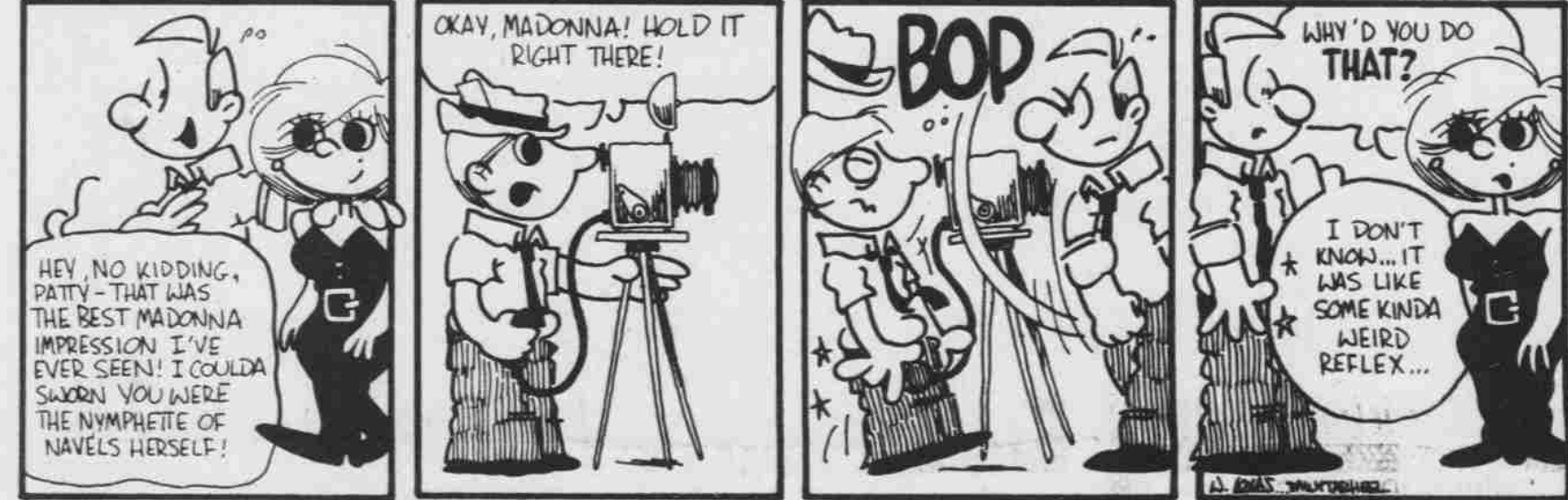
