After record-setting Texas stint, tracksters preparing for ACCs

Coach Dennis Craddock's UNC track and field team took last weekend off to rest up in preparation for this week's ACC championships at

Fourteen of the team's top runners competed in last week's Texas Relays in Austin as a final tuneup for the ACCs and came home with three new school relay records.

Senior All-American Jim Farmer led the men's team to a new record in the distance medley relay with the fastest 1,600-meter leg of his career. The team of Clive Harriott, Robert Vineyard, Johan Boakes and Farmer finished fifth with a time of 9:33.05, breaking the old record of 9:39.04, which was set in 1972. Farmer's 1,600meter leg of 3:57.01 was the equivalent of a 3:58.02 mile run, the first sub-four minute mile of his career.

The 1972 race was run at a yards distance, making it five seconds






