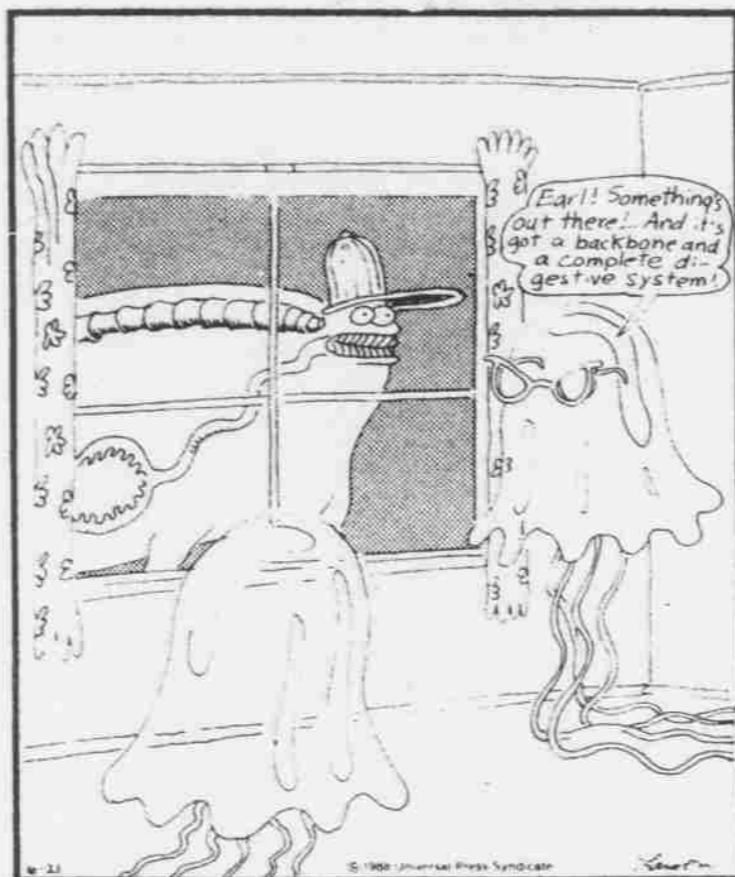

Due to circumstances beyond our control, Bloom County will not be seen this week.

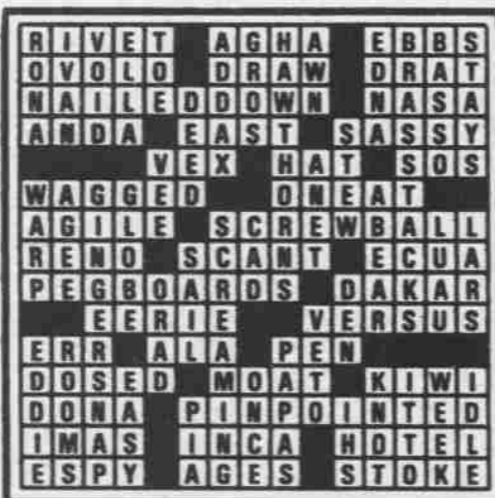

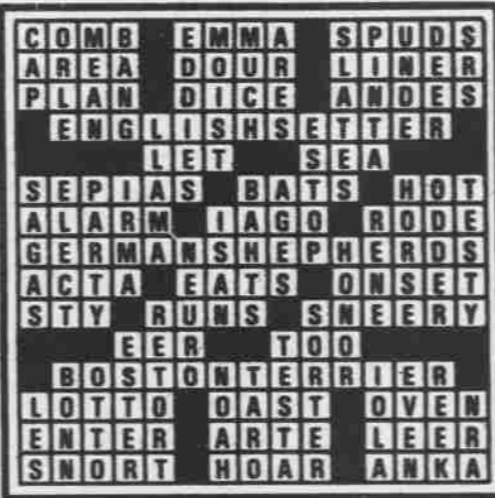

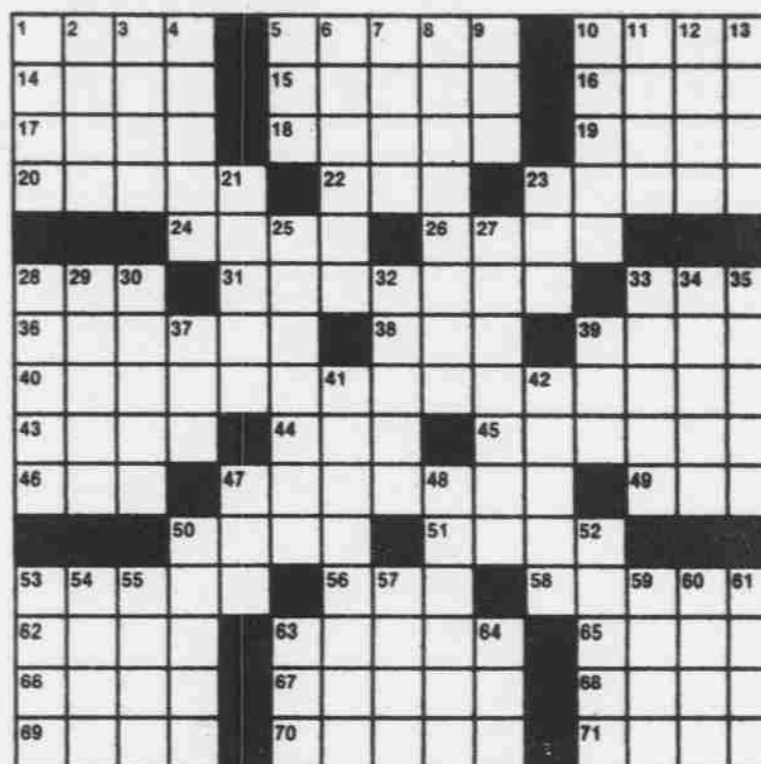
