Fox to add nights

LOS ANGELES — The Fox network plans to add up to two more nights of prime-time programming and a Saturday morning children's block, a spokesman said.

The network is planning to introduce a Wednesday night and Friday night lineup as early as this fall, spokesman Michael Peikoff said Monday.

The Wednesday schedule should include movies made by Fox's motion picture arm and new made-for-television films, Peikoff said. On Friday night, Fox is considering the one-hour program *The Outsiders*, based on the movie and book of the same

name, and the one-hour show *The Kids Are All Right*, from the creator of *21 Jump Street*.

The network is also working on a Saturday morning lineup aimed at children ages 6 through 11. Fox also has set a tentative date of April 21 for a special on the Rolling Stones concert tour.

The network currently offers programs on Saturday, Sunday and Monday nights to its 128 affiliates, representing 90 percent of the nation's television markets.

Elvis shows up

NEW YORK — Elvis Presley is still dead. But ABC will dramatize the singer's early years in a new half-hour series, *Elvis*.

The series will have a special pre-

miere Feb. 6 at 9:30 p.m. EST, the network said Tuesday. Filmed in Presley's hometown of Memphis, Tenn., and starring Michael St. Gerard, *Elvis* will start its regular Sunday night run Feb. 11, succeeding *Free Spirit*, which ABC has canceled.

ABC said *Free Spirit*, which premiered last September, will have its final broadcast Sunday. Special programming will fill its time period on Jan. 28 and Feb. 4, ABC said.

TV sets revamped

NEW YORK — NBC-TV and a French electronics company, Thomson SA, plan to announce a joint venture to develop an improved television system that would likely lead to high-definition TV.

They have been working at the

non-profit David Sarnoff Research Center in Princeton, N.J., to develop advanced television systems.

They have been working on what is called Advanced Compatible TV. The system would improve the picture on TV sets while allowing continued use of conventional sets.

The new system would require only minor, low-cost adjustments to existing equipment at local TV stations. The venture eventually is expected to develop true high-definition television, which would produce much sharper pictures.

But development of the HDTV system would require broadcasting signals to be re-assigned by the Federal Communications Commission because it would use a wider broadcast band than conventional broadcast signals.
