bers was taken away to give the board the authority it needs to operate.

"Most organizations have ex-officio, non-voting members," he said.

Former Student Body President Bill Hildebolt, who will be an ex-officio member until May commencement, said there usually was not an obvious form of block voting on the board that would affect the outcome of a vote.

The decision not to let ex-officio members vote should not have any impact on policies because the votes are not divided, Hildebolt said. "The final vote shouldn't be greatly affected," he said.

But ex-officio members may believe the meetings are not important now because they can no longer vote, Hildebolt said. "There may be less of an incentive for student leaders to go to the board meetings," he said.

But student representatives have more impact through their reports than their votes, Hildebolt said.

"The alumni association asks for a report at every meeting," he said. "This is where students have the most impact. I don't know that there's really a point in fighting to get the vote back."
