

# Lesbian Thespians take alternative approach to Cinderella fable

A young servant girl in distress, a royal ball and a fairy godmother who waves her wand and wham-o, instant magic. The Brothers Grimm's "Cinderella" is a staple fairy tale for children of all ages.

The "Cinderella" familiar to so many of us, however, has been revised a little. Cheryl Moch has added a few new twists to the old favorite. The Triangle's Lesbian Thespians is performing her play, "Cinderella, The Real True Story."

June for this year's Lesbian and Gay Pride Month, and the play is not what one might expect, unless, of course, one has seen the Thespians in action.

The Lesbian Thespians began in September of 1989 when the idea was entertained in a newsletter that circulates in the lesbian community. There was "an overwhelming response," said Laurie Wolf, co-producer of the group. After months of planning and preparing, the group performed Sarah Dreher's "This Brooding Sky" to full houses in Durham and Chapel Hill.

This year the group decided to take on a much larger project with the South-

ern premiere of Moch's "Cinderella, The Real True Story" in two acts. The play has a cast of 20 characters, which includes men, but not where you would expect them.

Although the plot is familiar, the specifics differ "radically." "There is an underlying political message about tolerance, but the show is generally a campy romantic comedy," said co-producer Dori Drachman. "Lesbians and gay men face serious struggles in our daily lives, and we want to rejuvenate ourselves and our community with a healthy dose of humor," Drachman said.

This goal contributes to one of the goals of Lesbian Thespians — to have fun. Their other goals include being visible in the community, celebrating their own culture and showing the general public as well as the lesbian and gay community, Wolf said.

Theater is a very visible art; therefore, Lesbian Thespians call the public's attention to the lesbian community and what it has to offer.

Lesbian Thespians portrays lesbian and gay culture more realistically than does "straight" media, which do not deal with the issue, Wolf said.

Another ambition of the group is to give lesbians a chance to emerge from their own culture and to celebrate that culture, Wolf said.

"Lesbian Thespians creates a forum for lesbian actors and technicians," Wolf said. It is a space where they can safely play lesbian roles and be "out" as performers.

"Because theater is an art that thrives on visibility and personal expression, homophobia stifles an actor's primary means of communication," Wolf said. "Being closeted on stage hurts us both personally and artistically."

The Thespians are receiving support from local businesses, organizations and

individuals. This year's shows are dedicated to Bob Sheldon, owner of Internationalist Books, who was shot to death in February. Bob was a long-time friend of the lesbian and gay community.

Performances are scheduled for June 7, 8, 14, 15, 21, 22 and 28 at the Durham Arts Council People's Security Theater. All shows begin at 8 p.m. The June 22 show will be interpreted for the deaf.

Ticket prices are on a \$7-\$15 sliding scale based on one's ability to pay. Reservations are recommended and can be made until 5 p.m. the evening before each performance by calling 929-6114.
