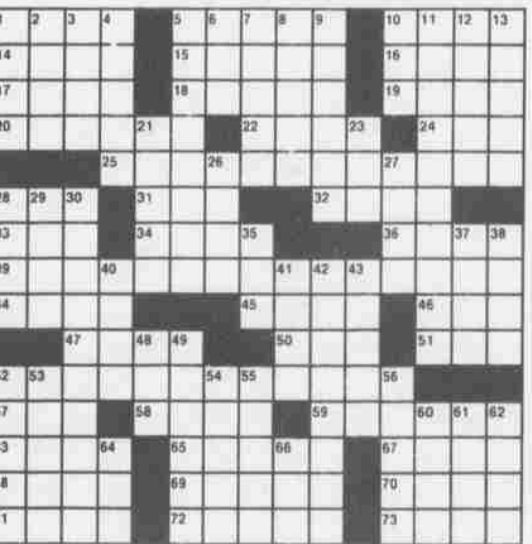

structure there may have been used by Union troops during the Civil War, the release stated. Steponaitis said researchers knew about where Steward's House was located, so there was a 50-50 chance that the group would be able to locate the exact location of the building. But some of the remains may have been destroyed when other buildings were erected, he said. Tepper said the project would generate interest among people on and off campus. "It's exciting to watch an excavation and imagine what is buried there from the past," he said. Steponaitis said the excavations could recover three types of remains. Archaeological remains such as building materials and bricks could be discovered, as well as evidence of detached buildings such as kitchens, wells and outhouses. "We'll find if there were buildings in these sights," Steponaitis said. "Even

though the walls are gone, the foundations will still be there." The excavators also could find artifacts, which are things people used and threw away. "A lot of that stuff just got scattered around the buildings they were generated from," Steponaitis said. The third type of items the excavations could recover are food remains, especially around Steward's House, he said. Bones and food scraps that have been preserved can tell researchers what types of food people ate in the 1800s, Steponaitis said.

Cooper said the bike patrol will cost less than the yearly maintenance of one police vehicle. "That's worth it to us, if we can reduce crime more effectively and cheaply," she said. Before beginning their patrols, officers underwent a training program and learned about nutrition and proper stretching. "The officers each ride some 20 to 30 miles a day, so physical training is essential," Cooper said. Porreca said it will take time to assess the advantages of the bike patrol. "It is still so new," he said. "If it even works a little, it will be doing what it's supposed to do."
