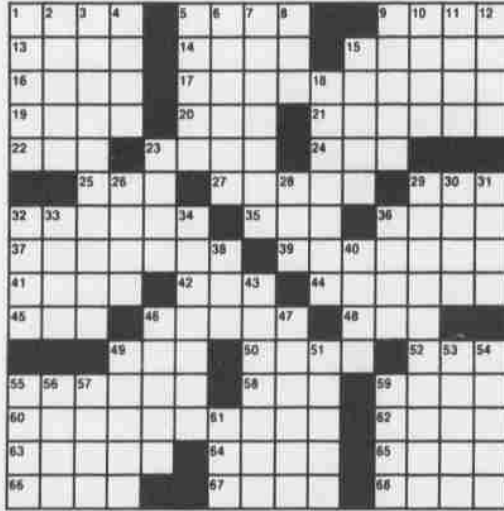

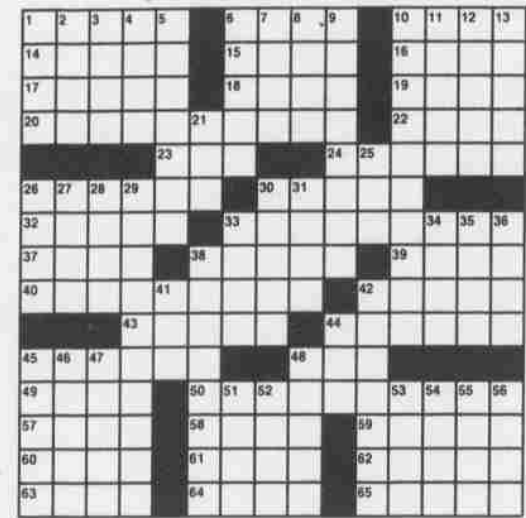

male track-and-field performers. Next, she played doomed Playboy Playmate Dorothy Stratten in "Star 80."

Other movies include "Creator," "The Mean Season," "Superman IV," "Sunset" and the miniseries "Amerika." This summer, she played dual roles in "Delirious."

Her most recent movie, "Falling From Grace," will be released in February. "Larry McMurtry wrote it, and in some ways it's like 'The Last Picture Show,'" she said. "It's a slice of life about a rock singer who wants to go back to his home town in Indiana to live. John Mellancamp is the singer, I'm his wife. I'm more or less his conscience, who tries to show him what he's about."

Hemingway has two daughters, Dree and Langley, ages 4 and 2, and is married to writer-producer Stephen Crisman. "We met when he was running the Hard Rock Cafe in New York," she said. "I saw him across a crowded room and said, 'That's the man I want to marry.' I met him the next day."

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
