said the company solicited donations from its customers and passed the contributions on to local charities.

Notices informing customers of community needs are included in power bills.

Duke Power matches customers' donations up to \$25.

Randy Wheelless, communications specialist for Duke Power, said the company had given \$400,000 last year, the maximum amount the company would contribute.

"The program has been pretty successful as far as interest from consumers is concerned and cooperation from local agencies," Wheelless said.

Wheelless said consumers and the company's contributions together last year amounted to approximately \$1.2 million.

Flick said community contributions to the IFC were "on target."

any student organization. The organization receives \$150,000 a year in student fees and supplements that with money from admission feasts events.

Mike Goode, a member of the Union's paid program staff, said the board of directors was completely responsible for deciding who would fill the position of president.

"It is a system set up to pick an individual who has what the board of directors has in mind," Goode said. "The board of directors represents the students, and we trust that they will decide what is best for the Union."

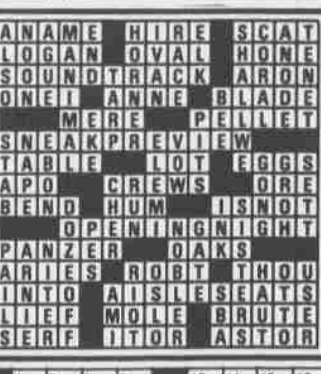

Bryant said she was not impressed by Woltz's comparison.

"I understand their economic point but this is America, and they are laboring under a completely different set of circumstances," she said. "There is no reason for them to be told they have to take less, if anyone should be taking less, it is the rich."

Hardin said several members of the UNC staff were working full time to address the problem. The real difficulty will come in presenting the recommendations to the state legislature, he said.
