proved FDA standards, the article states. Ward-Grobes would not comment on the studies.

Colby said the FDA's approval of food irradiation despite the questionable results of the studies was "unconscionable," and shows the FDA's lack of credibility.

"The FDA is very prone to mistakes." he said. "In the 1980s, the FDA is more a political body than a scientific body." Everett said that irradiated foods produced by the Vindicator plant were safe

But other area grocery stores have not endorsed a ban.

Joann Boone, public affairs coordinator for Kroger, said Kroger did not plan to carry irradiated foods but might reconsider if customers demanded them.

The problem for many people is that irradiation conjures images of "radio-activity and birth defects," Carroll said. "With a lot of people, it's an emotional issue rather than a scientific one,"

he said. But a research scientist who has done studies on the subject is not convinced

of the safety of irradiation. Vijayalaxmie, a scientist who studied irradiation in India, fed freshly irradiated wheat to rats, mice and monkeys in several 12-week studies.

The studies showed depression of the animals' immune systems, increased levels of embryonic deaths and abnormal numbers of chromosomes. These chromosomal abnormalities have been linked to cancer, Vijayalaxmie said.

Animals that were fed untreated wheat and those fed irradiated wheat that was stored for three months showed no abnormalities, she said. An additional study was performed

on malnourished children, but it was terminated after six weeks when the children began to show chromosomal abnormalities from the freshly irradiated wheat, she said.

The children had no chromosomal abnormalities when a study was performed eight months later.

"Just because the FDA has given (irradiation) clearance, that does not mean everything is safe and sound," Vijavalaymie sa 'I want solid proc

1990 FDA report of studies performed on irradiated chicken, the report stated that the FDA "has found no evidence of significant vitamin loss in (irradiated) chicken" and concluded that irradiated poultry would not have "an adverse impact on the nutritional value of a person's diet."

The FDA requires that irradiated foods be labeled with the radura, an international symbol for irradiation, and the words "Treated with radiation" or Treated by irradiation."

Colby said he hoped states would ban irradiated foods because of the lack of reliable evidence in support of the safety of irradiation.

"You see a huge controversy in the scientific community," he said. "This controversy must be settled before we make guinea pigs out of the human population."

The government should enact more stringent health regulations on the food industry to control salmonella rather than turning to irradiation to clean the food after it is contaminated, she said, According to Louria's article, some
