ning for other offices, there is no law against placing Perot's name on other campaign advertisements, Demers said.

"To my knowledge, I don't think (the placement of the ad) is stepping on anyone's toes," he said.

Thad Beyle, a UNC political science professor, said that continuing to link the two independent candidates together could benefit Mavretic's campaign.

"Anything in the election period to

heighten awareness that you are an independent candidate for governor, you should do," Beyle said. "If Perot is the vehicle, and people seem interested, why not use it?"

The DTH advertisement listed the gubernatorial candidate's political experience and made a plea for local Mavretic supporters to sign his petition for governor. Perot's qualifications were not mentioned in the ad.

Despite the efforts of his supporters, Mavretic said he could not keep an accurate account of his campaign's progress. To get on the Nov. 3 N.C. ballot, Mavretic and Perot must get 68,391 signatures.

"The problem with a petition drive is you never know how it is going," he said.
