Wyatt weekend for tennis: Frosh contends for 2 titles Golf

ATHENS, Ga. - North Carolina freshman Darryl Wyatt advanced to the finals of flight B singles with five wins in the 25th annual Southern Collegiate Tennis Championships held at the University of Georgia.

In doubles action, Wyatt teamed with UNC senior Sean Steinour to move to today's semifinals in the B Division. The Tar Heel tandem advanced by ousting Alabama-Birmingham's Christian Paul and Tobias Spanke 7-6, 6-3.

Wyatt, the eighth seed, earned a singles championship berth with a 6-2, 6-4 downing of Mississippi's Ali Harnadeh in Sunday's semifinals.

Earlier Sunday, Wyatt moved on with a 6-2, 6-0 quarterfinal thrashing of Jan Fredrikkson of Murray State. Wyatt will face UAB's Paul for the title. Wyatt opened the tourney Friday by defeating Chad Whitfield of East Tennessee State 6-3, 6-1. Saturday, Wyatt defeated Michael Spake of The Citadel 6-2, 6-0 in the second round and Roger Mills of South Alabama 7-6, 6-2 in the

third UNC's Steinour, unseeded in flight A singles, reached the third round with a three-set win Friday against Murray State's Pontus Hiort, and by defeating Georgia's Hector Nevares in straight sets Saturday.

Steinour was bounced from the tournament Saturday by fifth-seeded Michael Kirsten of Alabama-Birmingham 6-3, 7-5.

gia Southern 7-6, 6-0 Friday and Stuart Hill of Samford Saturday before falling in the third round to UAB's Paul, 6-4, 6-2

The Tar Heels, 11-0 on the season, allowed just one shot on goal in the two games. Lilly added an assist to her threegoal output versus Arkansas-Little 100 Rock. UNC's Mia Hamm, the nation's leading scorer, scored twice against UA-LR and added a goal and an assist Mia Hamm

in the win against Creighton.
