ACC women's hoops title may be on its way to College Park

As sure as the sun rises. As sure as a pig squeals. As sure as a Mom loves shopping. That's right. This is not the projected order of finish, this is the order of finish for ACC women's basketball teams in 1992-93.

No doubts. Go ahead, bet the ranch on it. W. Maryland: Head coach Chris Weller doesn't really care all that much about preseason polls and picks. "Ranked or unranked, we're real confident of our position," she said.

So never mind that Street & Smith Magazine ranked the Terps No. 3 in its preseason poll, three spots ahead of ACC foe Virginia. Also disregard the selections of 6-foot-4 center Jessie Hicks and 5-10 guard Malissa Boles to the magazine's preseason All-America first team. Hicks looks to continue her success in the low post after leading the conference in blocked shots (47) and field-

goal percentage (59.1) and leading the team in scoring (14.5 points per game) and rebounding (7.4 boards per game). Boles brings a flamboyant style with a dash of cockiness to the Terrapin backcourt. She scored 13.6 ppg during the 1991-92 campaign.

Maryland finished last season with a 13-3 record in the conference, good enough for second-place ACC honors. After gaining recognition as Naismith National Coach of the Year, Weller has proven that she has the skills to lead the Terrapins to their goals.

2. Virginia: The No. 1 question of the preseason for Cavalier head coach Debbie Ryan has been, "Who will re-

place point guard Dawn Staley, two-time National Player of the Year?"

Her answer? 5-5 senior Dena Evans will take over at the point. "If Bobby Hurley can play 40 minutes per game, so can she — it's her team," Ryan said.

Virginia's strength originates from its frontcourt, where the identical twin towers of Heather and Heidi Burgerer. Scoring comes easy for the Burges, who combined for 27.2 ppg last season.

While Ryan has plenty of semi-experienced reserves at her disposal, the scoring production of the subs is suspect. Preseason polls rank the Wahoos as a solid top-10 squad, and Ryan hopes to make her fourth straight Final Four.

But unlike the previous three, Ryan hopes to win a national title this time.

3. North Carolina: While heralded as "one of the nation's most-improved teams" by The Washington Post, the 1991-92 Tar Heels tallied a 9-7 ACC record to finish third in the conference. UNC head coach Sylvia Hatchell hopes her squad can pick up where it left off.

Youth should play a big role in the Tar Heels' performance this year and in the years ahead. The nucleus of the team is made up of two juniors and five sophomores, with five newcomers also thrown in for good measure.
