"I like the work all right. I'd like to go into production if I can. The assistant director for "Lawrence of Arabia' is a Negro. That was a Sam Spiegel production. The thing is, the producer puts up half the money and makes the movie, and Columbia, say, puts the movie out under its name - because Columbia has the machinery for releasing a movie, and the producer has the machinery for making it. The thing about this business is, it's big money, and you're dealing with a race of people that wants to see money spent the best way. That's the Jews. They run all the financial You don't want either. part. They're not afraid to spend money, but if they're going to, they want it spent the right way, they want the best. So it doesn't matter to them whether a man

"I don't want to get on the screen myself. That gets too involved. That's very hard work. I mean, you see actors and actresses with all the fine cars, and the mansions and everything, but they have to work for it. The best supporting actor this year was Ed Begley, and he's about sixty, so he's been around for a while. The best actress Ann Bancroft, and she's about 30, but she's been on the stage, she's had experience. Of course the best supporting actress was Patty Duke, in 'The Miracle Worker,' and she's only fourteen. But most of the actors and actresses have to come unless you're box office -

ly act, but the women like him. "I think I'd like to be a production manager. But I don't plan to spend the rest of my life in New York, unless I get really involved with his work. I'd like to come back here and go into real estate when I get older. "I have to admit. I feel more at ease in New York than I did here. They have a public accommodations law there, in the whole State, and there are not many ways they can get around it. They may not like it, but you've got the law on your side, so who cares what they think? People are prejudiced in the north, but it's not as open. It's a little harder to see than it is down here. Like a hotel, I'll call up a hotel and make reservations, and then when I get there they say they're sorry they don't have any room. Down here they'd just say no, they wouldn't make the reservations anyway. don't know which is better.

"I live in Greenwich Village. It's nice there, it's quiet, and you see a tree now and then, I go to Harlem frequently, I have lot of relatives up there. They're tearing down a lot of the old buildings and putting up new projects. Some of the slums are still there.

"I came down here and I was surprised. I thought everything would be over here by now. I mean, this town is famous for its liberalism, I didn't think anything like this would be going on here. I've met a lot of people in the Committee for Open Business, and I think it's very effective. I went to a workshop. One of the things that makes it effective, I think, is that they're very secretive. They don't tell you what they're going to do. It's all in the committee."

He came down hard on Governor Sanford. "I try to keep myself as informed as I can about what's going on here. I saw him on TV." He didn't expect Governor Sanford to ask for a halt in demonstrations, and was disappointed when the Governor did. "He's straddling a fence.

"I don't think we're going to have a Southern President, I don't know of anybody in the South qualified to be President. A Vice President, yes, but not a President. You know, I hate to think of what other countries are making out of everything that's going on in this country.

We send soldiers to Viet Nam to stop the trouble over there, but we can't even take care of it in this country. It doesn't make sense. We're supposed to be a democratic country, we're this, we're that, but what are the foreign nations making out

of all this? It's not logical. "The trouble with the Negroes in New York is that a lot of them go there to get away from something. You can't just run away from something like that. I went there for a purpose, and if you go to something, instead of from something, I think it's all right. But you can't run away from it."
