

Chapel Hill Swim Club Member Sets New Mark

Eight records fell on the first day of the Carolinas Junior Olympic Long Course Swimming Meet last Friday at Charlotte, one of them to a Chapel Hill Swim Club member, Laura Clark. Miss Clark, home two weeks from a two-week tour abroad,

clipped one-half second off the 50 meter freestyle record set last year by another Chapel Hill swimmer, Deane Mullis. The new mark was :31.1. A disappointment Saturday night was her second place in the 200 meter individual medley.

A fast touch gave the race to Mary Jane Thomas of Charlotte's Johnson Memorial "Y" in 2:57.2. Miss Clark's time was 2:57.5. With determined competitive spirit, she returned to the block eight events later to win the 100 meter freestyle by holding off a strong Karen Hammond, Spartanburg, S. C., for the last 15 meters of the race.

Thrilling to watch Friday night was Becca Whitaker's surge to the front at the beginning of the 100 meter butterfly and stirring win. A consistent competitor in the past, Miss Whitaker has always had a rousing finish. Sometimes with too much ground to make up to rate a win, Miss Whitaker has been training on a sprint to the front and subsequent sustaining race. Her efforts paid off Friday as she came within three-tenths of a second of tying the meet record.

An exception to the belief that a swimmer lessens as a threat when he moves up an age group is George Coxhead, a consistent worker who won his specialty, the breaststroke, for the second consecutive time in major competition. Two weeks ago at Shelby, he set the meet record for the event, in which he has been even stronger as an 11-12-year-old competitor than he was as a 10-and-under.

Ken Wilson, intermediate breaststroke, who advances to a new age group next season, bowed out in fine style Saturday night by winning the 100 meter breaststroke. His summer's conditioning efforts were evident in a well-balanced performance against the seasoned competitor from Statesville, Jack Steele.

Not all results for Chapel Hill, competing against 34 Carolina teams, were as exhilarating as five firsts. A judges' decision gave Raleigh's Wahl a third place in the 50 meter breaststroke over Margaret Warden, CHSC.

Both girls were timed in :44.7. A Charleston "Y" swimmer, Nancy Belcher, topped Anne Coxhead, CHSC, in their close midget breaststroke event. Miss Coxhead also was a touched out in Shelby in this event. Coach Mike Lawler commented that his petite swimmer gave everyone else a body length whenever she got on the blocks, a not too recommended practice in close competition.

Disqualifications cut into the team's winnings as four strong CHSC relay teams were cut after qualifying in their age groups. A factor in the consistently strong team's power, was the weakening of its ranks by sickness before the squad left Chapel Hill. Ruth Bowers had pulled her elbow at the Club picnic the weekend before, Nancy Holt, Peter Barnes, Fran Friday and Bill Richey had been out of practice with a summer virus for several days, although Miss Friday and Richey swam in Charlotte.

There will be a regular joint hearing before the Board of Aldermen and the Planning Board of the Town of Chapel Hill at 7:30 p.m., August 26, 1963 at the Town Hall to hear the following requests:

1. A request for rezoning Glenn Heights Subdivision from agricultural to RA-20.
2. An amendment to the zoning ordinance recommended by the

Planning Board which would require off-street parking in the Central Business Districts as follows:

a. There would be only one Central Business District instead of Central Business District-1 and Central Business District-2 as at present.

b. Off-street parking would be required for all new buildings.

c. Off-street parking would be required for additions to buildings existing at the date of passage of this amendment of 10 percent or more of the gross floor space.

d. Commercial buildings at the time of passage of this amendment would be considered conforming as far as parking is concerned and could be rebuilt to the original floor space.

e. Off-street parking requirements would be:

Commercial buildings such as stores, restaurants, offices, and so forth one parking space for each 400 square feet of gross commercial floor area.

Hotels and motels — one space per bedroom with an allowance of 10 percent of the parking space required for bedrooms to be used for other commercial use in the hotel or motel buildings.

f. Required spaces should be within 600 feet of the use to which they pertain.
