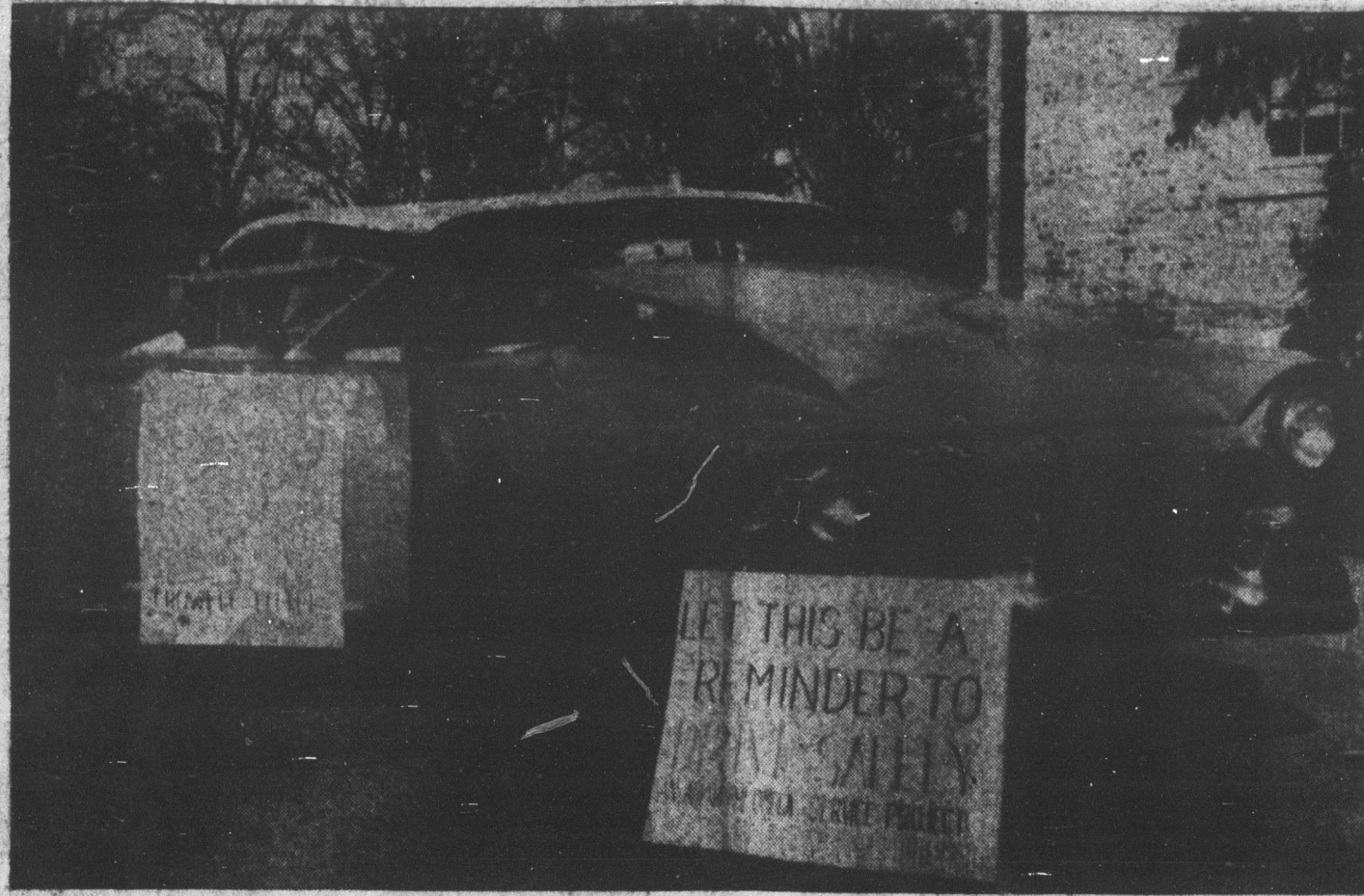

Registration Begins Here For Jan. 14 Referendum

Orange County voters yesterday began registering for the January 14 Statewide referendum on Legislative redistricting.

Their votes will help determine the fate of an amendment to the State Constitution which would increase the Senate from 50 members to 70 and reduce House membership from 120 members to 100. Passage of the amendment in effect would give the state's smaller, rural counties veto-power over all legislation.

Those required to register for the referendum include persons who are not already registered in a County book or who have changed their precinct since the last general election without registering in their new precinct.

Re-registration of persons already signed up is not required. Two more registration days

will be held before the election—next Saturday, December 28, and the following Saturday, January 4, from 9 a.m. until about 5 p.m. Challenge day will be January 11.

To be eligible for registration a voter must have been a resident of the State for a year, of his precinct for 30 days prior to the election. Registrars must also give prospective registrants a literacy test, although the literacy test is ordinarily not required if an individual can satisfactorily fill out the registration card.

The referendum will be the same as a general election, permitting absentee ballots. Applications for absentee ballots must be submitted in writing to Sam T. Latta, chairman of the Orange County Board of Elections, Hillsboro.

Blair Publishes Manly Wellman Book

An award winning book by Manly Wade Wellman, "Settlement on Shocco: Adventures in Colonial Carolina," for young readers nine to thirteen, has been published by John F. Blair, publisher, of Winston-Salem.

"Settlement on Shocco" is fiction based on the facts of regional history and has won the Literary award sponsored by the Carolina Chapter Tercentenary Commission for prose fiction dealing with North Carolina history prior to the American Revolution.

The story begins a little over two hundred years ago in what is now the southern part of Warren County, when a frontier family followed an Indian trail through the wilderness to Shocco Creek and there made a home for themselves.

By 1783 this family along with other settlers found it necessary to form counties, courts, county offices, and militia to protect themselves from exorbitant taxes—Lord Greville's unscrupulous rent collectors, dishonest land dealings, and Indian War. They were proud colonists who realized that their years of labor spent in building the frontier were endangered by King George's tyranny, and that they must soon assert themselves to be free from his oppression.

Manly Wade Wellman was born in the Portuguese West African colony of Angola, the son of a medical missionary. He has published over forty books, many of them dealing with North Caro-

lina, where he has lived since shortly after World War II. Fourteen of his books are novels for young readers dealing with North Carolina's past and present.

Mr. Wellman lives here and conducts a creative writing workshop at Elon College. When he is not writing, he spends much of his time studying Carolina history and folklore.
