Critic of World's Fair Labor Resigns

NEW YORK, June 19.—Jay Downer, head of the New York World's fair amusement control board and a critic of union labor tactics at the exposition, has resigned.
Downer said today he asked to be relieved because his duties in lining up the play area had been completed. He had voluntarily continued his work since expiration of his contract on May 8, he said.
Downer in an address last Tuesday asserted that union labor had taken the attitude of a "tiger after the first taste of blood," using tactics with some concessionaires that had "bled them white."
