The devices included under the term Union Label are three in number: A Label proper, a Shop Card, and a Button. Most Unions choose a Union Label, but the barbers decided on a Shop Card. Placed in the window of a shop, the Card is the most effective form for the Barbers' Union.

This Card is displayed only where good, competent Union barbers are employed. Patronize no other. It is printed in black, red, blue, and good.

At present the Journeymen Barbers have their own Union Shop Card and the Hairdressers and Cosmetologists' (beauticians) Department of the Union has a separate Union Shop Card. This Card is displayed only where expert, competent Union beauticians are employed. Patronize no other. It is printed in mauve, buff, and black. 


