Labor Organizer Killed By Head Of Corporation

NEW YORK, May 10.—Angry words gave way to fists and flying knuckles to bullets yesterday in a heated dispute climaxed by the slaying of a union organizer in a Brooklyn garment factory and arrest of the firm's 64-year-old president on a homicide charge.

Shot and killed during the argument over organization of 35 women in the Trio Coat corporation was Vito Trimarco, 30, an organizer for the New York Cloak Makers' joint board, composed of nine craft unions in the industry and affiliated with the In-ternational Ladies' Garment Workers'

ternational Ladies' Garment Workers' union.

The arrested corporation president was Guisseppe Fritachi, who had long opposed the union's efforts. Police said a permit had been issued in his name for a pistol which they seized after the killing.
