

**I. T. U. Asked To
Come Back Into
A. F. of L. Fold**

NEWARK, N. J. — Newark Typographical Union No. 103 has sponsored a resolution setting in motion the legal procedure to initiate a membership referendum on the question of reaffiliation of the International Typographical Union with the American Federation of Labor.

The resolution, which must be endorsed by 150 local unions, declares that "the question of adjusting differences between the ITU and AFL regarding observance of autonomous rights of the ITU have never been clearly presented for consideration by the membership, having been confused with partisan consideration which should have no place in deciding this issue."

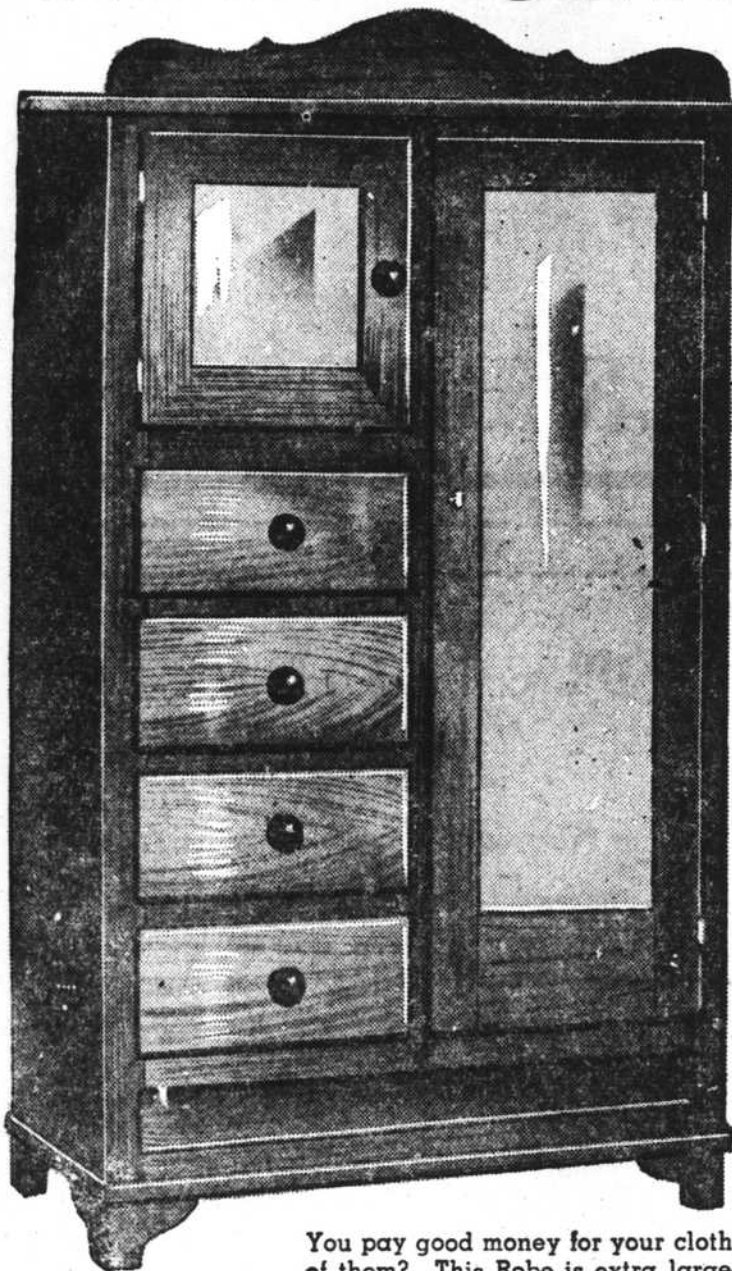

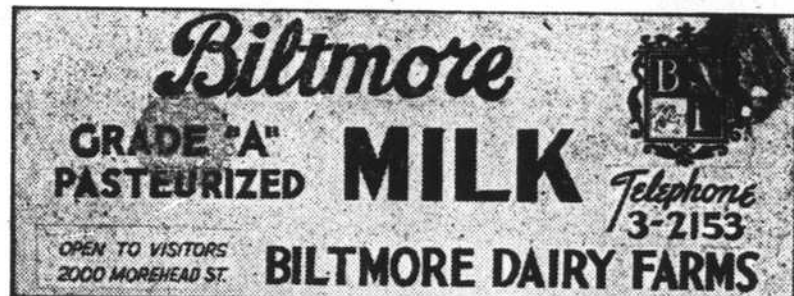
The lunch room, staffed by Red Cross volunteer canteen workers, will serve hot meals without charge to servicemen. The lounge will be equipped and staffed by the USO.
