The AFL, as well as many international unions, and state and city central bodies, has gone on record repeatedly demanding that Great Britain, the mandatory power in Palestine, honor the terms of its mandate, and permit the free entry of Jews into Palestine. Recently they have urged the carrying out of President Truman's recommendation that 100,000 survivors of the Nazi extermination camps be permitted to enter Palestine immediately.

Organized labor's sympathy with the aspirations of the Jewish people to build Palestine into a free and democratic homeland is especially deep because of the important part played in the building of Palestine by the Palestine Federation of Laobr known as the Histadrut.

Histadrut, with 170,00 members, who together with their families make up over 40 per cent of the Jewish population of Palestine, plays a determining part in the Palestinian economy.


