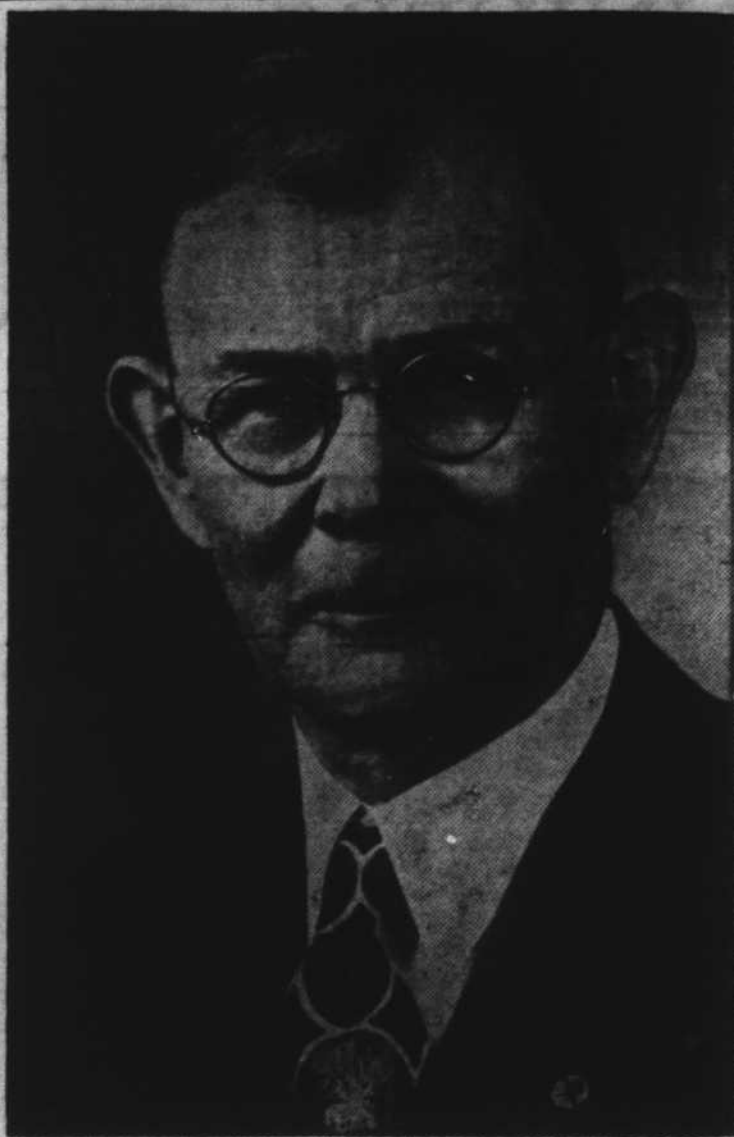

Naming Gross as ECA Mission Chief Brings Praise From Norwegian Leader

Oslo, Norway.—The recent appointment of John E. Gross as chief of the Special Mission to Norway has been received with wide acclaim by labor leaders in Norway.

Gross, former president of the Colorado Federation of Labor, succeeded A. E. Staley, Jr., who resigned on May 1, to return to private business in America. Gross previously was labor adviser to the ECA Special Missions to Denmark and Norway.

Minister of Commerce Erik Broffoss said, in part:

"Mr. Gross has taken a deep interest in Norway. I feel that he has a far-reaching understanding of Europe's and Norway's fundamental economic problems. He also covers a wide field of experience. He has seen both sides of industry. I am sure I am not mistaken in assuming that as a trade union leader he has more than once pounded the table in support of his arguments or claims for higher wages and better working conditions. The tide of events, however, also brought him into the position of a railway company executive. This, I am sure, will prove an advantage during the time he is stationed here in a period when the question of labor relations and industrial democracy are more in the melting pot than ever before."

Konrad Nordahl, president of the Federation of Trade Unions, wrote:

"It is with the greatest pleasure that I, as an old trade union man, read that Mr. John E. Gross has been appointed the new chief of the Marshall Mission to Norway."

"During the time Mr. Gross has been labor adviser for the mission, we have had an excellent cooperation. Now that he has been ap-

pointed to head (the mission) we presume this as an expression of the appreciation and respect which the U. S. Government have for the American trade union organizations and their men, and for the great progress the American trade union movement has made throughout the years. We wish John Gross good luck in his new and responsible job."

Haakon Lie, general secretary of the Social Democratic Party: "The Norwegian Labor Party holds a majority in Norway's Parliament, and Norway's government is a Labor government. The trade union movement and the cooperative movement have a decisive influence in our country's economic and social life. It is therefore

particularly gratifying that the man who is now taking over the leadership of the ECA Mission to Norway, Mr. John Gross, is a man whose whole life has been devoted to organized labor. We know that this will be a guarantee that the cordial cooperation which has existed between the ECA Mission and the Norwegian people and their officials will be still further broadened and strengthened. Labor in Norway sees in the appointment of Mr. John Gross a new demonstration of the American Government's desire that Marshall aid shall be an instrument for deepened confidence and friendship between the democracies in the new world and in Europe."

DAVIS NAMED CHAIRMAN OF ATOM DISPUTE PANEL

Washington.—President Truman created a special labor relations panel to prevent work stoppages in vital atomic energy operations.

He named William H. Davis, former head of the War Labor Board, to be chairman. He said 2 other members would be named in a few days.

The panel was established on recommendation of a special commission, on which Davis served, which studied atomic energy labor relations for the President.

Mr. Truman stressed that the panel will be of top-flight, last-resort nature.
