In the year ending June 1, a total of 75,668,581 pounds of farm commodities had been contributed for distribution in 22 of the 43 nations served by CROP's sponsoring agencies: Catholic Rural Life, Church World Service (22 Protestant denominations), and Lutheran World Relief. Gifts in kind included 28,975,504 pounds of wheat for 38% of the total, 22,061,357 pounds of corn for 28%, and 13,185,661 pounds of beans for 17%.

Meanwhile, plans are well advanced for extending the CROP drive nation-wide this year. Already, organizations have been set up in 20 states, and 11 others are in the process of organization for harvest season campaigns.

Fresh fruits and vegetables declined 1.5 per cent, contrary to the usual seasonal movement, as prices of cabbage and lettuce dropped 20 per cent, green beans and spinach more than 6 per cent, and potatoes more than four percent. Prices of onions advanced 9 per cent and oranges 8

Prices of wearing apparel, declining for the eighth consecutive month, fell .5 per cent in the May-June period to a level of 5.6 per cent below the peak reached in October, 1948. Prices for work clothing and men's and boys' furnishings continued to fall. Lower prices were reported for women's rayon dresses and slips, nylon hose and cotton dresses.

The index for the cost of housefurnishings, fell 1.2 per cent from May 15 to June 15, as prices of sheets, curtains, electric refrigerators, radio-phonographs, living room, bedroom and dining room furniture continued to decline. House furnishings prices in June 15 were about six per cent below the October peak.

Rents increased slightly to continue for the the third month the upward trend found in all of the cities surveyed.


