SENATE GROUP BACKS BILL FOR MINE SAFETY
 Washington.—The Senate Labor Committee approved a bill granting authority to federal mine in-

spectors to close dangerous coal shafts.

The safety measure before the Labor Committee has the support of the United Mine Workers and is opposed by representatives of the coal industry and by state mine agencies.

The UMW started a drive for a federal law after the mine disaster at Centralia, Ill., in 1947, in which 111 miners were killed. An investigation of the disaster brought out that federal mine inspectors repeatedly had recommended that the pit be closed until safety measures were taken.

Under current law, Federal inspectors may only recommend action. State agencies alone have the power to close mines or take other steps to enforce safety regulations.
