National Favorites

Picnics and potato salad... Here, the "winning bit" is in the dressings. Versatile, too, for other salads and with leftovers as sandwich spreads.

Potato Salad

- 4 medium potatoes, freshly boiled 1 cup thinly sliced onion 1 cup sliced celery 2 tablespoons chopped parsley 1 teaspoon salt

- 1/2 cup Zesty French Dressing 1/2 cup Egg Dressing

Combine diced potatoes (there should be about 4 cups), onion, celery, parsley and salt. Add French Dressing and 1/2 cup Egg Dressing, and mix together lightly. Cover and chill thoroughly. Just before serving, add remaining Egg Dressing. If desired, add three cooked frankfurters, sliced thin. Serves 6.

Old-Fashioned Boiled Dressing

- 3 tablespoons corn starch 1 tablespoon sugar 2 teaspoons dry mustard 2 teaspoons salt 1/2 teaspoon pepper Few grains Cayenne 1/2 teaspoon paprika 1 1/2 cups milk 2 egg yolks 1/2 cup vinegar 1/2 cup salad oil

Mix first 7 ingredients in a small amount of the milk to make a smooth paste. Add remaining milk. Cook over low heat, stirring constantly, until mixture thickens and boils. Boil 2 minutes, stirring con-

stantly. Remove from heat; gradually add to egg yolks. Return to heat for 2 minutes, stirring constantly. Remove from heat and gradually beat in the vinegar using rotary beater. Add salad oil; beat smooth. Cool. Makes 2 cups.

Egg Dressing: Combine 2 chopped hard-cooked eggs, 1 teaspoon chopped parsley and 2 teaspoons chopped chives, and fold into 1 cup Boiled Dressing.

Cucumber Dressing: Combine 1/2 cup peeled, seeded, finely chopped cucumber and 1 tablespoon chopped chives, and fold into 1 cup Boiled Dressing.

Sour Cream Dressing: Combine 1/2 cup sour cream, 1 teaspoon chopped parsley and 1/2 teaspoon onion juice, and fold into 1 cup Boiled Dressing.

Horseradish Dressing: Combine 2 to 4 tablespoons horseradish and 1 cup Boiled Dressing.

Zesty French Dressing

- 1 cup salad oil 1/4 cup vinegar 1 1/2 teaspoons salt 1/2 teaspoon pepper 1/4 teaspoon paprika Few grains celery salt 1/2 teaspoon sugar 2 tablespoons catsup 1 tablespoon lemon juice 1 1/2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce 2 cloves garlic

Measure all ingredients into a bottle or jar. Cover tightly and shake well. Chill several hours, then remove garlic. Shake well before serving. Makes 1 1/2 cups.
