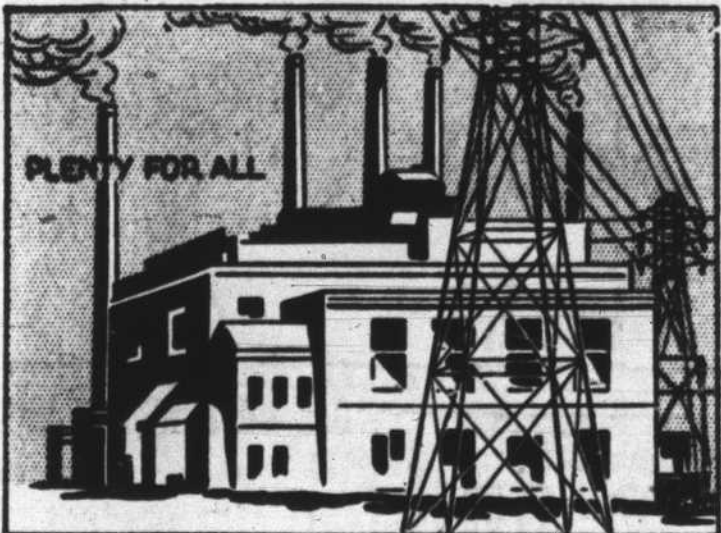

white-collar field. Millions of white-collar workers have seen their relative economic status move from bad to worse solely because of their inability to bargain collectively, on an equal footing, with their employers. A major effort must be made to greatly enlarge the sphere of organization in this area.

"Millions of workers in agricultural and canning industries, wholesale and retail trade, cleaning and dyeing establishments, hotels and restaurants, petroleum and natural gas industries, building service and maintenance, and numerous other fields are sorely in need of the protection and advancement which only organization can provide.

"Many of these industries present special problems from an organizational standpoint. They are the ones which have traditionally been most difficult to organize, and concerted effort of a truly pioneering nature will be required.

"Though the task is difficult, it is far from impossible. The American Federation of Labor is relying upon your ability to undertake this task with all of the vigor and ingenuity that will be needed for its successful completion.

Letter press printing in the graphic arts means the direct application of inked type and engravings or other type material to paper.

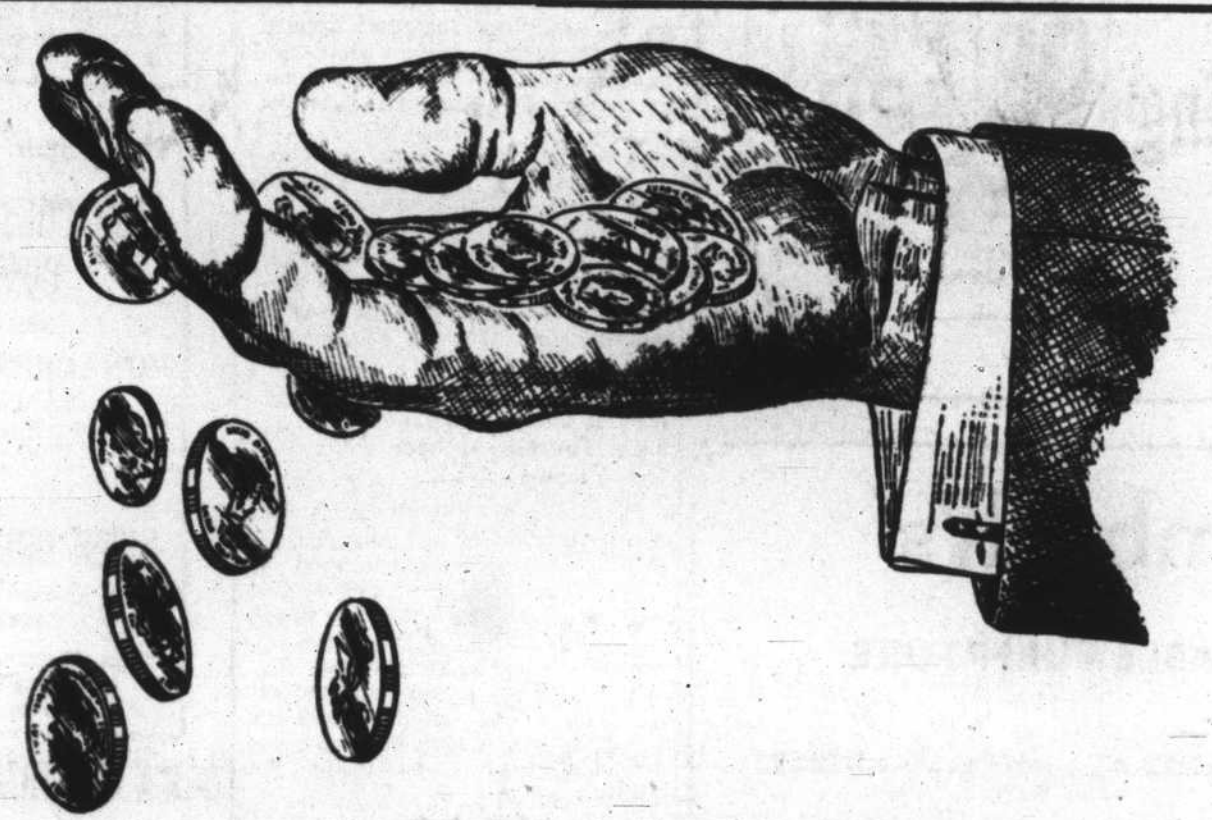
