### Waste Not, Want Not

"Waste not, want not," says an old proverb that will never be out of date; and every housewife knows nowadays that if she doesn't waste usable leftover food, she won't be lacking in attractive and tasty ideas for serving her family.

Leftover fruit juice, for example, can find an excellent place for itself in an inexpensive fruit-flavored gelatin dessert like the one pictured below. And leftover fruits—canned or fresh—may be used as a garnish, as shown here, or sometimes they may be a part of the shimmering gelatin mold itself.

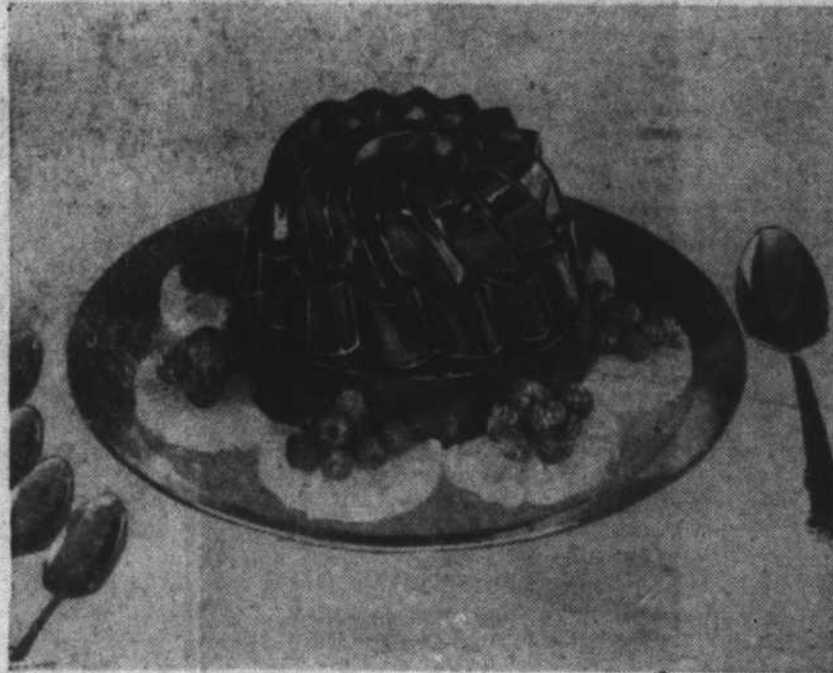
Gelatin desserts are inexpensive and easy to make, and many variations in flavor are possible. In this case, pineapple juice is

combined with raspberry-flavored gelatin in an appealing, summery dessert to suit a simple supper or a more elaborate company dinner. Fruit used as a garnish always adds a pretty touch and points up the happy combination of flavors.

### Raspberry-Pineapple Delight

- 1 package raspberry-flavored gelatin
- 1 cup hot water
- 1 cup canned pineapple juice

... dissolve gelatin in hot water. Add pineapple juice. Turn into mold. Chill until firm. Unmold. Garnish with raspberries and half slices of wedges of pineapple. Serve with plain or whipped cream. Serves 4 to 6.

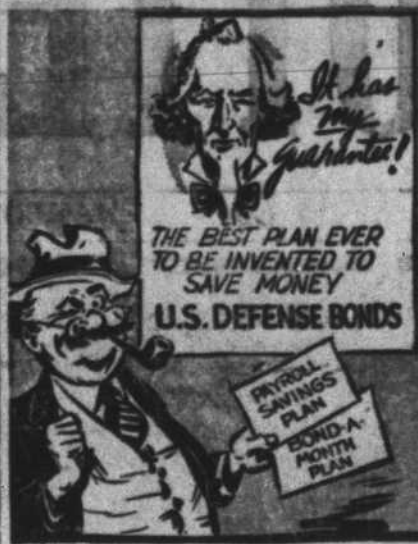
