

FIVE YEARS OLD.

The Democrat is five years old today. With this issue we close our fifth volume. During the time of the paper's existence under its present name, it has changed hands several times, but has never failed to make its regular visits to its patrons.

A brief history of the paper is about this: We believe it was about August, 1882, Mr. D. E. Staeback established the paper here under the name of "The Commonwealth." About November following it suspended. In December following the present editor assumed editorial control of the paper in connection with the Principalship of Vine Hill Academy. It was run under that management until August, 1883, when it was sold to Mr. Geo. M. Carr, who edited the paper for several months, with Mr. Geo. A. Newell assistant, as we remember. Mr. Carr sold the paper back to the writer who again sold it to Geo. A. Newell who edited it until sometime in the year 1881, when it suspended. In the fall of 1881, Mr. Chas. E. Haskett revived the paper under the name of THE DEMOCRAT, which it still bears. Mr. Haskett edited the paper for only a few months, when a stock company was formed who bought the paper, making Mr. W. W. Kitchin editor and the writer Business Manager, while we (the writer and Mr. Kitchin) were teaching together in the Vine Hill Academy.

The paper ran awhile under this management when it was turned over to Hon. W. H. Kitchin as "Editor and owner," as he put it at the head of the paper.

Under his management the paper waded through the first Cleveland campaign and the first three years of Cleveland's administration.

In December 1887, Hon. W. H. Kitchin sold the paper to the present editor who assumed editorial control on 23rd of that month, and has managed it solely ever since. The press on which Mr. Staeback printed the first issue of The Commonwealth is still at work sending out the weekly issues of The Democrat. Since it was first set up in this town it has been torn down, moved and set up, to the certain knowledge of the writer, six times, and once moved into the country.

As has been stated, the present management began December 23, 1887, for which we have been wholly responsible both editorially and financially. As to how well and faithfully the work has been done by this writer, we are willing that a criticizing public shall judge. We greet you still. Pay us up every dollar due, give us fair patronage, in subscriptions and advertising, and we promise continued fidelity to the trust the work of a journalist places in our hands.

QUAY'S AGENTS IN NORTH CAROLINA.

Charles A. Cook, who has just been appointed U. S. attorney for the Eastern District of North Carolina, much to the disgust of his competitor, William Smith O'Brien Robinson, who claimed the place as the leader of the "regulars," owes his success to Frank Willing Leach, secretary of the Pennsylvania Republican State Committee, and private secretary and willing tool of Matthew Stanley Quay. Leach was down in North Carolina last fall, in personal charge of the campaign, acting and plotting under the direction of Quay. He established headquarters at Raleigh, and from that point he managed affairs and distributed the corruption fund of \$20,000 which Quay had intrusted to him. He found Cook a servicable and zealous coworker in his "delicate and perplexing position," as he describes it. In the report which he made to Quay, Leach said that he had "worked 20 hours a day for two months, and I slept every night with a revolver in his night shirt and escaped by the skin of his teeth from the Ku Klux and Red Shirts." He claimed the distinguished honor of having elected his colored friend, Henry Chestnut, to Congress from the Second District of the State.

When the Administration was finally established, Cook made application for appointment as chief of division in the Treasury Department, and Leach "backed" him. Failing in the Treasury application, Leach went to Attorney General Miller and pushed his man for the United States district attorneyship of the Eastern District. He told Miller what he and Cook had done, recounted their services to the party of moral ideas, and alleged that he could have "redeemed" North Carolina with more time and money. The candidate for the Supreme Bench was partial to Leach and he came off victorious. Leach wanted to "control" the appointment of the United States attorney for the Western District, but Mr. Blaine headed him off, and Charles Price was selected. "This was a hard blow to me," said Leach, who charged that Price did not even vote for Harrison, that he was counsel for the Richmond and Danville Railroad, and in the employ of Calvin S. Brice, and that all the active Republicans of North Carolina were dead set against him. But Cook, he said, was a man who would "ratle things."—National Democrat.

NEW YORK LETTER. Regular Correspondence. New York, Oct. 28, 1889. The topic of the week in financial and business circles generally is the gigantic railroad combination which has just been consummated between the Union Pacific and the Chicago and Northwestern. These two companies control altogether nearly 11,000 miles of railroad extending in all directions from Chicago. Hereafter they will furnish each other with all the traffic they can command through their respective agents, and in fact, the two systems will be run as one. The agreement by which this was brought about takes effect December 1st, and lasts for ten years. The most significant part of the deal is the fact that the Vanderbilts are the prime movers, and will now be enabled to carry out their long-cherished project of a road extending from the Atlantic to the Pacific under their own control. They already have all the Eastern connections to make the proposed route a favorite one with travellers and shippers. This transaction will undoubtedly hasten others of a similar character, and it is freely predicted in Wall street, that before ten years, all the railroads of the country will be managed as one gigantic system.

An assessment of \$3,000 has been levied on each box owner of the Metropolitan Opera House for the purpose of meeting expenses for the season. This looks like a pretty high price to pay for one form of amusement in a single winter, but it is less than the actual cost, inasmuch as the boxes are the personal property of the occupants, and originally cost \$15,000 apiece. There are several boxes for sale now and they are quoted at \$25,000 each. The reason for these fancy prices for amusement is the increasing demand for opera boxes from numbers of rich families who have come from all parts of the country, have settled down here in New York, and who find that accommodations at the opera are absolutely necessary as a part of their social life. Some of the owners rent out their boxes receiving therefor \$60 a performance, or \$4,000 for the season. First class opera is a little steep but New Yorkers must have it.

LETTER FROM WASHINGTON.

Representative Mills, whose name became a household word through its connection with the democratic tariff bill during the last Congress, has taken quarters here for the season. He has entirely recovered his health, which came near breaking down from overwork last winter. Mr. Mills will not have a tariff bill during the Fifty-first Congress, but he proposes to see that the republicans do not pass one with abnoxious features.

The last meeting of the cabinet was very long and stormy. The President submitted a rough draft of his first message to Congress, and the members of his official family took turns in jumping on it with both feet. The thing has of course been kept very quiet, but such matters always get out in some way or other. According to the informant of your correspondent, Secretaries Blaine and Windom were the principal "kickers." Mr. Windom objected to the financial part of the message as out of line, and Mr. Blaine had decided objections to the stand taken on certain matters within the province of the State department. The arguments were long and somewhat heated, and finally when it was agreed to submit the matter to a vote of the Cabinet, the President was defeated, the only votes he received being those of Attorney General Miller, Postmaster General Wanamaker, and Secretary Noble. The President then expressed his willingness to change the disputed matter, and peace reigned once more. But for how long?
