HAZERS GET FOUR MONTHS IN PRISON.

Orange Jury Finds University Student's Guilty of Manslaughter.

Hillsboro, March 15.—The twelve Orange county farmers sitting in judgment upon the case of the State against Ralph W. Oldham of Raleigh, William L. Merriman of Wilmington and Aubrey C. Hatch of Mount Olive, set a precedent in the criminal proceedings of North Carolina and gave the practice of hazing a stunning blow when, at 3:10 this afternoon they returned a verdict of manslaughter against the three sophomores.

The announcement of the verdict by the foreman of the jury came at the end of three hours deliberation, and the decision arrived at by the twelve men who had sat patiently on the case since Thursday was cause for no surprise.

Even the fathers of the boys had displayed nervous anxiety over the welfare of their sons after Judge Peebles' charge to the jury at 11:35 in the morning, and one father, who had watched every step in the progress of the trial, evinced extreme nervousness during the morning session and broke down in tears at the noon recess of court.

Simmons Chairman Finance Committee

Washington, March 14.—The democratic forces took charge of the United States senate last night, elected new officers to preside over that body and paved the way for the reorganization of committees, and a new control of legislative affairs.

The personnel of the finance committee, which is to handle all tariff bills, became definitely known last night. As now agreed upon it is: Democrats—Chairman, Senator Simmons, North Carolina; Senators Stone, Missouri; Williams, Mississippi; Johnson, Maine; Shively, Indiana; Gore, Oklahoma; Thomas, Colorado; James, Kentucky; Hughes, New Jersey.

In addition to this, he retained the places he had previously held as member of the Committees on Commerce, Coast Defense, Engrossed Bills, Civil Service, Expenditures in Department of Agriculture, Interoceanic Canals, and Transportation and Sale of Meat Products.
