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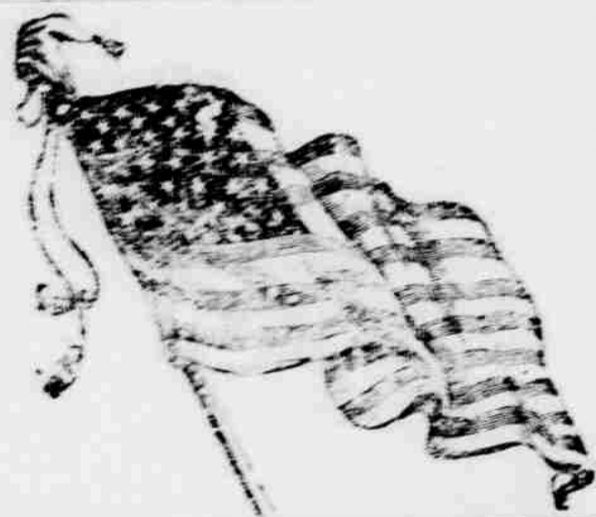

**A WORLD CONGRESS OF  
LABOR**

The Convention creating a per-  
manent organization for the pro-  
motion of labor interest through-  
out the world has been completed.  
The document consists of forty-  
one articles. This new world-wide  
labor organization will consist of  
a General Conference of labor rep-  
resentatives and an International  
Labor Office. The conference is  
to be held at least once each year  
and will include representatives  
of employers as well as workers.  
It will meet at the seat of the League  
of Nations where the Interna-  
tional Labor Office will form a  
part of the League organization.

The Labor Office will act as a  
general clearing house for labor  
information. The office will be in  
charge of a Director who will be  
appointed by the governing body  
and will select his staff which is  
to include a certain number of  
men, from different nationalities.  
A governing body of twenty four  
members will control the Labor  
Office. This body will consist of  
twelve government representatives,  
six members elected by delega-  
tes representing employers, and  
six delegates of working people.

The results of this great move-  
ment for the peaceful adjustment  
of labor problems of all countries  
seems likely to be one of the most  
important results of the war.

**ANOTHER REBELLION IN  
MEXICO**

President Carranza, of Mexico,  
is apparently facing a new revolu-  
tion in that distressed country.  
General Aurelio Blanquet, Mexi-  
can Minister of War during the ad-  
ministration of President Victo-  
riano Huerta, has arrived in Mexi-  
co, according to an announcement  
made by his secretary, Roberto  
Gayen, and it is understood that  
he is second in command to Gen-  
eral Felix Diaz, who has long been  
a political opponent of Carranza  
and is believed to be at the head  
of the revolutionary movements.

According to Mr. Gayen, it is  
General Blanquet's purpose to  
reorganize the Diaz forces, over-  
throw the Carranza Government,  
and establish the Constitution of  
1857, which, he says was repudiated  
by Carranza.

General Diaz, according to Gay-

en, has 40,000 troops scattered  
throughout fifteen of the twenty-  
seven states of Mexico. General  
Blanquet is seventy years old and  
holds the rank of Field Marshal  
in the Mexican army.

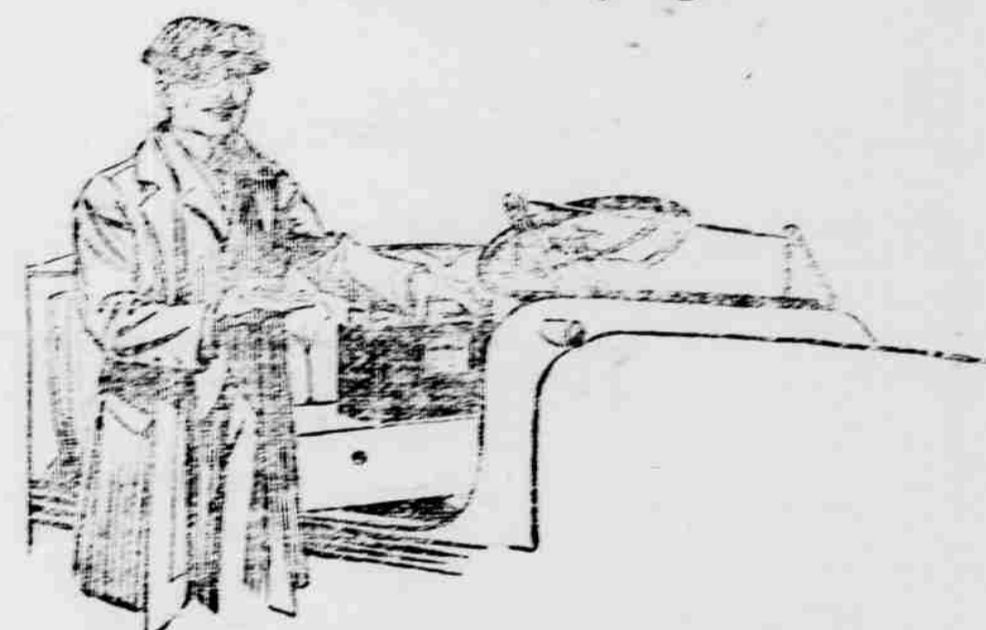

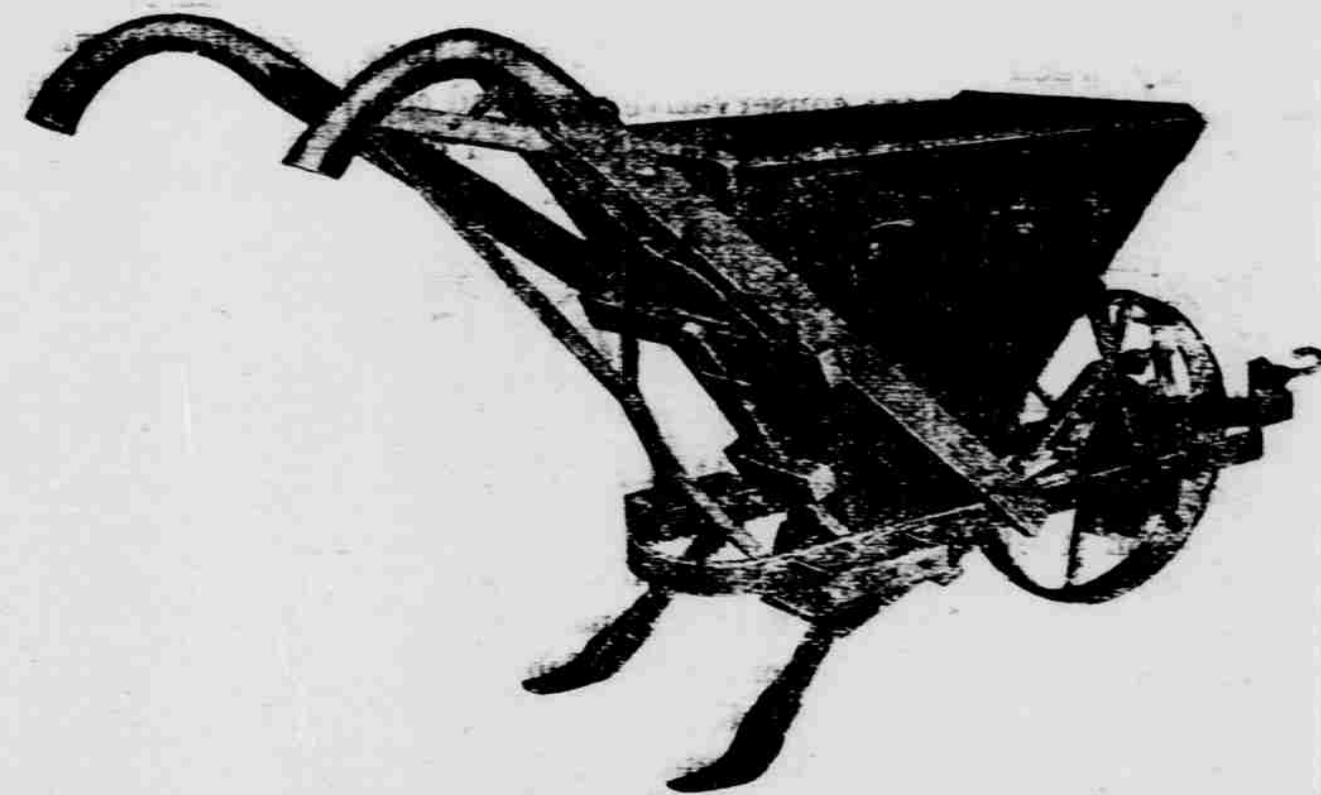
