### GET THEM WITH THE GOODS

At the end of July the supply of creamery butter showed an increase of 129 per cent against the figures given for the same time last year. Yet the price was 53 cents a pound, against the Drug Store and they brought me former price of 41 cents.

It may be the fault of hoarding profiteers, or wage-boosting profiteers, or profiteering middle men. The blame probably rests on more than one of the above groups of sinners. We can hardly believe that one group alone would dare to be the sole cause week. of such extortion.

Whatever the cause, it seems that the government's inquiry is well timed. And it is well to call it an inquiry, and not a crusade, or reform, or any other romantic name. It is an inquiry a recognition of our ignorance of the facts, and a desire to enlighten our ignorance. And as the blame probably rests on more than one mischievous agency, it is necessary to identify them all, and determine the proportion of guilt—at the time of the investigation, and not beforehand. Our natural tendency to make one the goat for all should be resisted in these deliberations. Let us get the truth first, and do the vituperating afterwards.

### "THE TRUTH SHALL MAKE YOU FREE."

A recently discharged soldier went into civilian life—and then decided to return to the army. His reason was that he found it easier to talk the language.

He didn't say what language, but after a few quotations his position became plain. In the army they are less polite than they are in civil life, but they know each other better. In civil life we are civil. We rarely say what we really mean. If we are invited anywhere, and we don't want to go, we don't say so; we merely have a previous engagement. If we are asked whether we like something that the other fellow likes, we say "yes," even though it gives us a pain in the rhombohedral gland.

We profess personal likingeven enthusiastic affection-for people to whom we want to sell something. If we are made the

recipients of honey-flavored overtures, we feel a sinister suspicion that we have been picked as prospects.

It seems unfortunate that any one should have to go into the army to escape from this kind of thing. For many people it is an excellent thing to be in the army, but it is sad that there should be no other environment-except, the navy-where perhaps, things are called by their real names. Sincerity in these two branches of public service is natural; the members don't have to sell anything to make a living. But a fairly good alternative would be found in the development of a corresponding sincerity in civil life.


