Laws of the UNITED STATES.

Passed at the Second Session OF THE THIRTY-SEVENTH CONGRESS.

CHAP. XXXIV. - An Act making Appropriations for sundry Civil Expenses of the Government for the Year ending the thirtieth of June, eighteen hundred and eighty-six.

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,000,000 be, and is hereby appropriated, for the fiscal year ending the thirtieth of June, eighteen hundred and eighty-six, for the following purposes: Survey of the Coast. For the survey of the Atlantic and Gulf coasts of the United States.

payment of which is no longer provided for by the quarterly appropriation of \$100,000 and seventy-nine thousand and thirty-nine dollars and seventy-nine cents.
