We understand a gentleman residing in this city contemplates erecting at an early day, a row of dwelling houses with all the modern conveniences, and that they are to be let at a much lower rate than is now charged for inferior buildings.

A score of comfortable dwellings at reasonable prices could probably be rented if now ready within the next twenty four hours. We know of at least half a dozen gentlemen now boarding, who are anxious to obtain houses, but as yet they have not been able to do so.

The construction of side-walks in some parts of this city would bring into market many houses and lots now almost useless to any body because not to be reached without great inconvenience.

We are aware that there are difficulties in the way of this improvement but it is a matter worth considering, whether the property holders would not find it for their interest to act voluntarily in the matter and not wait for formal action.

SEVEN years ago it was denied that the party which elected Mr. Lincoln had any designs upon the peculiar institutions of the South; later it was declared that the war on the part of the United States Government was one merely for restoration of the States to the Union, and Northern politicians derided the instinct of Southern statesmen which declared that it was a war of victory or subjugation; still more recently Republicanism denied indignantly that negro suffrage would follow emancipation as inevitably as the sun creates warmth, and now the party of progress affects to believe that the enfranchisement of the blacks has not inaugurated an antagonism of races.

The Index states only half the story. There was originally no design upon the peculiar institutions of the South, nor was the war commenced for subjugation but these steps were forced upon the Government by the South. So too with impartial suffrage. Such a step was not dreamed of when the amendment to the Constitution was submitted; as to the danger of any inferior race ruling, that too as a matter entirely with the whites at the South to determine.

Preparations for Fall Trade. The present is the season of the year when merchants are most on the qui vive for customers; when the waning summer betokening the approach of the cooler weather admonishes the merchant to force off the unsold portions of his summer stock. There is no better way to do this than by advertising; indeed there is no plan half so efficacious. Displayed advertisements, often changed and liberally indulged in, are the surest means. The history of trade during the last twenty years, has endorsed this fact. The largest houses in the country owe the greatest amount of business transacted by them to a liberal and persistent method of advertising to their pertinacity in placing their goods in the most attractive light possible before the readers (and who is not a reader) of newspapers.

On the Confessional. At a recent breakfast speech by Earl Russell, he acknowledged frankly that during the late war he had not done justice to the United States, and he was persuaded that President Lincoln did all that was possible to do. He had thought when the slave States endeavored to establish their independence and the same time to continue and perpetuate the institutions of slavery, that "the Northern States ought at once to have proclaimed not only their own abhorrence, but the abolition and destruction of slavery."

The Raleigh Sentinel endorses an extract from an editorial in the Post. The Sentinel calls the Post Radical, ergo the Sentinel is a Radical sheet. We did not expect to convert so able an advocate of the Opposition in so short a time. Truly our mission hath already yielded good fruit. To others yet out in the cold we might say:—"While the lamp holds out to burn," but we forbear.

JUDGE JONES who recently died in a Louisiana jail while awaiting trial for murder had a very checkered career. He belonged to a respectable and wealthy family and if we mistake not originally studied for the ministry, but eventually took up gambling as a profession and after doing the Southwest, was one of the first of the numerous adventurers with TAYLOR'S army of occupation in Texas in 1846. Subsequently he followed Scott's column to the City of Mexico where he plied his business with considerable success.

JONES was polished and refined in his manners and personally very popular, but when he thought himself imposed upon he was rash and summary in obtaining redress. Hence his associations led him into frequent conflicts but he generally managed to come out first best. Notwithstanding many bad qualities there were many ennobling traits in his character and his memory will long remain green with the many whom he befriended.

The Michigan State Convention to reconstruct that State has had the question before it in regard to impartial suffrage. After a somewhat extended discussion it was decided to so word the body of the Constitution that no distinction should be made therein between the black and white races. The action of the Convention in this respect, will undoubtedly be sustained by the people as it will be in due time throughout all the Northern States, where the subject can be controlled by the Republican party.

Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, Wisconsin and Michigan, having decided in favor of manhood suffrage the other States will soon follow.

The First Bale of Cotton.

Last year, rewards were offered and received for the first bale of cotton brought into this market. The reward was tendered by some of the merchants of this city, and was eagerly contended for by the planters. The plan was undoubtedly of some benefit to both the donors and those to whom it was offered, and we are surprised that it has not been again adopted this season.

STEAM FERRY.—We are inclined to think that a Steam Ferry Boat would pay if placed at the Ferry opposite this city. An engine about the size and capacity of the one now in the little steamer IDA C. POTTER would suffice for the purpose, and we are inclined to think, without going into a calculation, that the investment of the cost of the boat would pay the proprietor of the ferry. The constantly increasing necessity of communication between the opposite sides of the river, and the difficulty and delay which are so often unavoidable now, would perhaps ultimately justify the new expenditure. We suggest this matter to the consideration of Mr. TAYLOR, the proprietor of the Ferry, and hope, if considered practicable by him, that the proposed plan may be adopted.

BASE BALL.—Wilmington is very much behind hand in one of the great customs of the day. She has not now, nor ever has had a Base Ball Club in her midst. We are behind the age, and while other cities have their athletic pastimes we here have none. The cooler days are fast approaching us now when vigorous exercise will prove pleasant as well as beneficial to the system, and for those who have been confined to the counter or the desk during the heat of the now passing summer, a little relaxation of the muscles of the arms and the fatigues of the mind would hardly be amiss. Past experience has proven that to inaugurate anything now here, it is only necessary for some one to overlook an obstacle and lead the way; a host of eager ones generally second the attempt of the first. In this instance who will be the leader? Who is the man to open the gate for himself and others and lead them into a course that will prove of vast benefit to all of sedentary habits in this community?

WORDS OF SENSE.—Hon. W. W. Boyce, of South Carolina, takes a practical view of the situation in brilliant contrast to the "heavy dignity" men. He writes to a friend: "A word as to the public matters. I think our people ought to register and participate in the elections. To do nothing, will be to commit suicide. I think the great point is to carry out Gen. Hampton's ideas, and show themselves thereby the friends of the colored people. Our people should recognize what is inevitable in regard to the legal and political rights of the blacks, and grant, of their own volition, what will be given in spite of them. By this course, harmony between the two races will be maintained, and political power in the State will remain in safe hands. All expressions through the press or otherwise against the dominant party here should be avoided. It is impossible at this time for the Democratic party to help the South. The great object of the South should now be, to get established in their political rights. There a feeling of confidence will take the place of present insecurity, and capital flow in from the North. I feel intensely for the unhappy condition of my Southern friends. You must not be discouraged—struggle on—affairs must improve."
