And today is the city treasury groaning under the expense that it has to meet in paying extra fees to the city physician for attendance on these existing cases of infectious diseases, the seeds of which were imported into this port months ago by the remissness of a previous quarantine physician. We are informed that some thirty or more cases of small pox recently originating in this city from the above mentioned importation, that have been attended by the city physician, have cost the city treasury about two hundred and fifty dollars each-a very considerable tax indeed, that should not have been in-
