New York, June 24.44 Billy Gib son, New York's leading promoter of boxing clubs, picks Frank Moran he Pittsburg white hope, nto beat Jack Johnson , when they meet in twenty-round fight in Paris next Saturday night. Gibson bases his opinion on Johnson's physical condition. He has received private information from Paris that the negro has taken off a lot of weight, but may not possess the strength and stamina that enabled him to whip Jeffries at

"There is no betting on the figh here," said Gibson today, "but I learn that Johnson is a 10 to 4 favorite in Paris. If I could spare the time to cross the ocean I would have a big bet on Moran simply as a good gam bling proposition.
