Neutralists Are Alarmed. Washington, Oct. 20.—If the Norwegian and Swedish merchant vessels destroyed by German raiders in Wednesday's raid were in the war zone at the time, their owners have no recourse, neutral diplomats stated tonight.

"Germany was simply following out the policy she has pursued since launching her submarine campaign—sinking neutral ships and raising questions afterward," said a Norwegian diplomat.
