RAID TURKISH BATHS TO ARREST SLACKERS

New York, May 9.—Four police raiding parties entered 10 Turkish baths between 3 and 6 o'clock this morning and arrested 75 young men who could not produce federal or state registration cards. The raids were made at the request of the federal authorities endeavoring to round up all military slackers.
