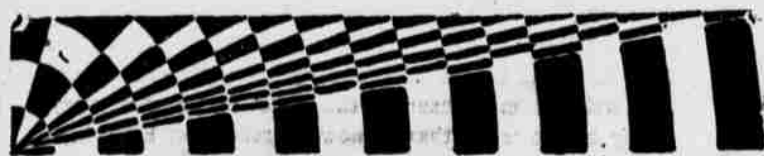

flag an ashook it defiantly toward the U-boat. The lad was still clinking to the colors held proudly above his head when he landed on the beach.

The German commander either took a long chance or had an exact chart of the dangerous shoals and shifting sand bars off the capes. It would be impossible for him to submerge to any great depth and the scene of his exploits was not one in which undersea boats might be expected to operate. Last night he was being hunted by patrol vessels and other war crafts.

New York, July 22.—The Perth Amboy was owned by the Lehigh Valley railroad and according to estimates of marine men here was worth about \$100,000. The value of the barges was estimated at approximately \$90,000.

Recent reports received here indicate that the cost of torpedoes in Germany at his time is not less than \$15,000 each.

U-Boat Planting Mines

Most officials still hold to the theory that a mine had destroyed the cruiser. In their opinion the submarine strewed mines in the trans-Atlantic ship line east of New York in the hope of destroying transports. One of these mines may have caused the sinking of San Diego.
