EVERY WHITE MAN CAN VOTE.

To take from ignorant white men the right to vote would be to insure the full return of the reign of the mob and the reign of riot in North Carolina. It is a lie to intimate that any white man can be or will be deprived of the right to vote in 1900 or 1901. No white man is really disfranchised by the amendment. If any white man is ever disfranchised in North Carolina it must be in consequence of his own folly, crime or indifference. The article itself does not disfranchise a white man. If a man's father or grandfather could vote in 1867, then any white man in North Carolina can vote now. If he votes now—in 1900 he will vote always. Ex-Senator Jarvis states it correctly in this:

"Every white man who is a qualified voter now will continue to be as long as he lives, so far as this amendment affects his right to vote. Every young man arriving at full age before January 1, 1908, can register and vote if he puts his name on the registration books before that date and he will continue to be a voter as long as he lives."

THE PLATFORM.

Following is the platform adopted by the State Democratic Convention. The Democratic party of North Carolina hereby approves, endorses and ratifies the principles enunciated and set forth in the platform of the national Democratic party of 1896. We denounce the tariff legislation of the Republicans, which has increased the burdens of taxation upon our consumers and increased the powers of trust and monopolies to rob the people.

Believing that under our present method of federal taxation more than three-fourths of our national revenues are paid by people owning less than one-fourth of the property of the country, we protest against such inequality and injustice, and in order to remedy to some extent this great wrong, we favor and income tax and all constitutional methods to sustain it.

We denounce the Republican party for its legislation fixing the gold standard upon the people. We denounce the Republican party for its legislation by which the people of territory acquired by the United States are taxed without representation and deprived of protection offered by the principle that the constitution follows the flag.

We are in favor of peaceful commercial expansion, but denounce imperialism and militarism. We cordially invite all voters without regard to past political affiliation to unite with us in support of our candidates for congress who favor the principles of the Chicago platform.

Why the Republicans and Populists Will Put Out Separate State Tickets.

The Republicans and Populists will put out separate State tickets and the public is thus made to believe that there is no alliance between the two parties. Senator Pritchard has authorized a statement that the Republicans and Populists in North Carolina will not fuse on the State ticket.

It is a fact that a close alliance on the terms then stated was agreed upon. The Republicans and Populists will put out separate State tickets and the public is thus made to believe that there is no alliance between the two parties.
