

# COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

Windsor, N. C., July 10th 1905

The Board of County Commissioners met at the usual hour, members present, C. W. Spruill, Chairman, G. L. Mardre, J. L. Harrington, J. H. Lawrence and Dr. L. A. Nowell.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

Ordered that Dr. P. C. Jenkins be allowed to list his taxes for 1903 of Roxobel township.

Ordered that Mrs. D. P. C. Jenkins be allowed to list her taxes for 1905.

Ordered that M. B. Gillam and G. T. Brett be allowed \$50 reduction on the regulation of their Sanderlin tract of land, Windsor township for 1905.

Ordered that J. R. Shield's land in Merry Hill township be reduced from \$17.50 to \$12.50 in valuation.

Ordered that John Henry Casper of Windsor township be allowed to list taxes for 1905.

Ordered that the land of J. J. Mizelle's estate be reduced in valuation from \$1500 to \$1200 dollars of Indian Woods township.

Ordered that W. P. Speller lands be listed at 100 and value reduced to \$800 of Windsor township.

Ordered that D. P. Mizell be allowed county part of \$500 valuation of land, wrongfully listed and taxed and recommend that the state part of said taxes be refunded to said Mizell.

Ordered that the George T. Hogard tract of land in Mitchell's township be listed to the Branning Mfg Co. and that said company also list its timber in Merry Hill township.

Ordered that W. R. Raynor be permitted to put on the tax list of Colerain township the abstracts now in his possession, from several persons who failed to list their taxes.

Ordered that L. B. Sutton's land of Windsor township be listed 179 acres and valued at \$1000.

Ordered that Haywood Bond have a reduction on the 50 acres of land bought of Lewis B. Sutton now valued at \$500 be reduced to \$400 in valuation.

Ordered that T. W. Holtoman be and is hereby appointed to have a bridge built over Lousin Swamp near Powellville and known as new bridge and to keep account of time and cost of building same.

Ordered that A. J. Cherry be allowed to list taxes of Windsor township.

Ordered that T. C. Bond's land in Woodville township be reduced in valuation from 600 500 said tract of land contains 90 acres, and that his 57 1-2 acres tract in Woodville township be reduced in valuation from \$600 to \$400.

Ordered that T. C. Bond guardian for Mary C. Francis, have a reduction on her land in Woodville township tract contains 142 acres from \$650 to \$500.

Ordered that W. G. Brown to be notified to appear before said Board of County Commissioners, at its next meeting on the 7th day of Aug.
