District baseball tourneys start today

Local teams take to the baseball diamond today for the Tarheel Leagues district tournaments.

Their destination? Williamston and the state tournaments.

District tournaments will feature 54 teams over four age divisions: 8-U, 10-U, 12-U and 15-U.

Because of the number of teams, the 10-U and 12-U divisions have been divided into East and West brackets.

Because Williamston is the host of the state Tarheel League tourna-

ments July 27-30, they are not required to play in the district event.

Therefore, the champion crowned in the 15-U, 12-U and 10-U brackets will join Williamston at states, while two teams will join the host team in the 8-U field.
