The Bertie County Board of Commissioners declined to adopt a resolution presented by one of its members and a group of citizens Monday night.

But, the group said they will be back with a similar resolution and

will continue to work with county leaders to find compromise.

The discussion of a proposed resolution supporting the Second Amendment right to keep and bear arms was sometimes heated as residents spoke about their beliefs, but ended with both citizens and commissioners leaving open a path forward.

March primary can do so beginning at 8:30 a.m. Thursday, Feb. 13. And, folks in Bertie County will have two places to choose from when voting early.

In Powellsville, voters can cast votes from 8 a.m. until 7:30 p.m. Monday through Friday from Feb. 13 through Feb. 28. One-stop voting will also be available from 8 a.m. until 3 p.m. on Saturday, Feb. 29.

Those wishing to vote in Powellsville can do so by going to the Powellsville Town Hall, which is located at 106 East Main St.

The other early-voting locale will be at the Bertie County Board of Elections, which is located at 210 West Watson St. in Windsor.

Voting will be available from 8:30 a.m. until 5 p.m. Monday through Friday Feb. 13 through Feb. 28. The Saturday, Feb. 29 voting will be available from 8 a.m. until 3 p.m.

We're in the clear for now.

Those are the assurances of Bertie County and Windsor officials following minor flooding late last week.

Bertie Emergency Services Director Mitch Cooper said the Cashie River had already dipped from minor flooding stage to the Action stage, and added the rainfall Tuesday and the rest of the week was not likely to change it.

"The upcoming forecast doesn't pose any concerns at this time,'

Cooper said. "Most of the rain today (Tuesday) will stay to our west, but we will keep an eye on the northern end of the county."

The deluge of four inches of rain Friday night was enough to cause an already elevated Cashie River to minor flooding stage.

Cooper said the major issue was at Livermon Park and Mini Zoo where there was

minor flooding. Windsor Town Administrator Allen Castelloe said some of the animals from the zoo were relocated to the
