No tax hike slated

Budget cut by \$700K in proposal

WINDSOR - No tax hike. Bertie County Manager Juan Vaughan II said his proposed budget for fiscal year 2020-2021 presented reflected no tax increase nor did it provide an appropriation from fund balance.

Vaughan said most funding was level for outside agencies, but county departments cut an average of five percent from their budgets a year ago.

"The proposed funding for the General Fund for FY 2020-2021 is \$24,755,534 which is a decrease of \$736,370 or three percent below the original budget ordinance for the current year, which was \$25,491,904," Vaughan said in his budget message. "The proposed General Fund budget does not include a fund balance appropriation or an increase in the
