Our Bird Friends In Winter
It is easy to have birds abou your yard in winter, if you wan
them, whether you live in town o them, whether you live in town or
country. In The Progressive Farm country. In The Progressive Farm-
er Alexander Sprunt, noted writer on nature subjects, gives the fol lowing definite instructions about how to attract bird neighbors:"To bring birds to your yard you must provide them with food A feeding table should be at least
three or four feet high. Place it in three or four feet high. Place it in
