State College Answers Timely Farm Questions

Q. Is it possible to tell how long a chicken has been laying by the bleaching process?

A. Yes, In yellow skinned birds the yellow color is given to the fat by a pigment called Xanthophyll. This is found just beneath the skin and as the bird lays, this pigment disappears in a fairly regular manner which indicates approximately the time the bird has been laying. Bleaching of the vent shows the bird has layed two to three eggs. Where the earlobes are bleached the bird has been in lay from two to three weeks. Bleached beaks mean from six to eight weeks of fairly heavy production and bleached shanks show that the bird has been laying from four to six months. The pigment returns after the birds go out of lay in the same order.

A. For best results manure should be applied during the fall and winter and either turned under at the fall plowing or disced in during early spring.
