

Over 500 Macon Farmers Used Ground Lime In 1939

The agricultural soil conservation program is a program to encourage better farming practices. Last year ground lime was made available through the program as a grant of aid. This means that farmers could secure lime and let the purchase price and the freight be taken out of the payment that was set up for the farm. Over 500 farmers took advantage of this opportunity and secured lime for their farms. Lime is available again this year at the same deduction rate of \$2 per ton delivered to Franklin, Otto, Prentiss, and Dillard, Ga. Orders for a considerable amount of this lime have already been taken at the County Agent's office for early delivery.

The following farmers secured lime through the soil conservation program as a grant of aid during the year 1939. This list is by townships and shows the total tons secured by each township. This list does not include farmers of Nantahala township because they purchased lime at Hewitts. Neither does it include lime purchased by other farmers of the county at the same quarry. Approximately four thousand tons of lime was secured by farmers of the county through the soil conservation program and from other sources.
