

## FISH BITE WELL OVER WEEK-END

### 310 Trout Caught From Wayah Creek In Two Days

Winton Perry of Franklin brought away the prize catch from Wayah creek in the Wildlife Management Area, eight miles west of here, this week-end. His 15-inch

brook trout was landed in the creek's Rough Fork branch. Thirty-one fishermen paid their dollar into the cooperative wildlife fund at the Wayah Game Protector's residence, making an average catch of 10 fish each. The limit is the state game bag limit of 12 fish of legal size. J. H. Aiken and Charles Robinson of Biltmore Forest caught a bag of 20 fish between them, with an average length of over nine inches. Wayah creek, with its two main tributaries of Rough Fork and

Camp Branch, has a combined length of three miles of fishable water within the Wayah Wildlife Management Area. To date 171 fishermen have checked in and out, which is almost twice as many as last year. Recently A. C. Balch, superintendent of the Walhalla fish hatchery, visited the rearing pools at Arrowood Glade on Wayah Creek, where the fish fry brought from Walhalla are reared to legal size. The U. S. Fish and Game Service cooperates with the Forest Service in operating these rearing pools.

Balch commended Laurie Smith, fish caretaker, on the special condition and growth he is getting on the fingerlings which are to be legal size and planted early next spring. Smith is proud of a new mush cooker that has just been installed, consisting of a 20-gallon black iron kettle on a wood burner where he cooks oatmeal mush mixed with scraps from the grinding of liver and gives the fish a varied menu. The money collected by the state game protector for fishing the cooperative wildlife management

areas is divided equally between the state of North Carolina and the U. S. forest service to help pay for the cost of the game protector and the planting of the fish and game.
