

Motorists Asked To Avoid Maneuver Area

The North Carolina State Highway and Public Works Commission has issued a statement calling attention to the Army maneuvers opening this week in the 16-county area in North and South Carolina. Although none of the major highways will be closed on account of maneuvers, all civilian traffic is advised to avoid this area as much as possible, since Army movements will be carried on over them throughout the maneuver period. Civilian traffic will not be barred from this area but motorists can avoid delay and inconvenience by refraining from entering the occupied territory while the war games are in progress. The eight North Carolina counties now being occupied by the army in preparation for the maneuvers are: Union, Anson, Richmond, Scotland, Hoke, Moore, Montgomery, and Stanley.

Selectees Advised To 'Travel Light'

Selective Service registrants en route to Army induction centers should "travel light", taking nothing but essentials so as to avoid inconvenience to themselves and to the armed forces, Brig. Gen. Van B. Metts, has cautioned recently.
"If you wish, take a small bag with a few clean clothes, a few handkerchiefs, socks, soap, towel, and other necessary toilet articles. These are not essential, for you will be issued necessary equipment by the Army, but they may come in handy should there be any delay in your induction," he said.

In the food campaign next year, Chairman Scott of N. C. U. S. D. A., says, the first objective of workers and farmers will be to

avoid the disastrous mistakes made by farm folk in trying to meet adjustments necessitated by World War I. "The plan is to observe

good farming practices all the way through, to protect the farmer's land and his future markets," the defense board chairman said.

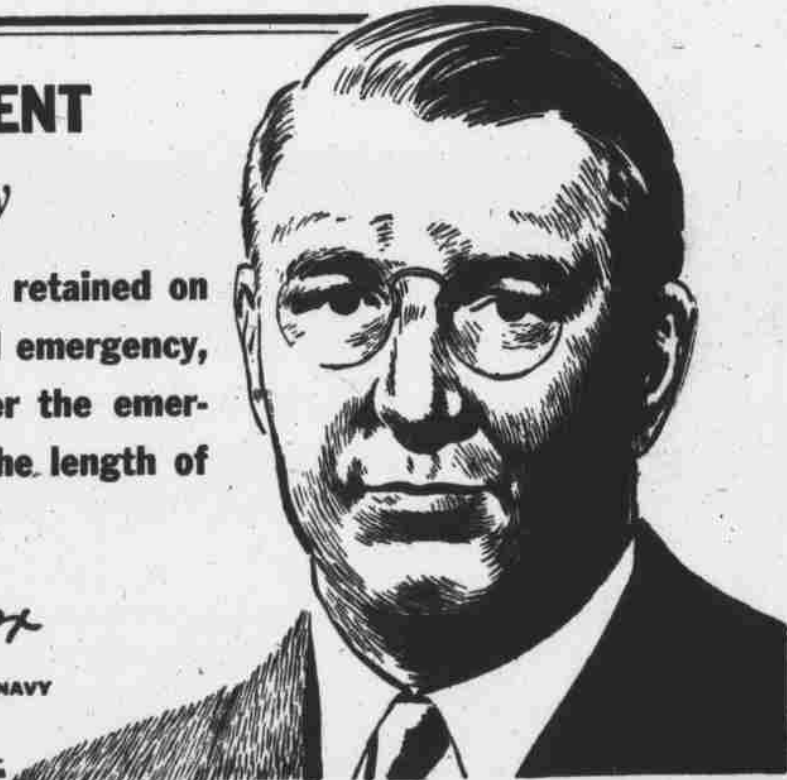
