A school on watershed man-agement, which is expected to attract foresters from the Chattahoochee, Cherokee, Pisgah, and Nantahala National forests, will be held at the Coweeta Experiment Forest station, near here, May 14 and 15, it has been announced.

Marvin D. Hoover, forester in charge of the Coweeta Experimental forest, and Dr. C. R. Hursh, of the Southeastern Experimental station, Asheville, have just returned from a tour of the southeast; on which they conducted schools on soil and water problems of the region, based upon findings at the Co-weeta forest.

Checking erosion and maintaining forest soils long has been recognized as a major factor in increasing the yields of timber for harvest, it was pointed out, but in recent years the subject of water supplies for cities and towns, and for factories moving into this region has become increasingly important also.
